reflect extension and not expansion for 5 years. Resubmission was done in F.21 that indicated clearly that, they wanted an extension of COI for them to benefit from the already approved list of items that they didn't use before.

The core of this application is importation of 2,500 Lithium Batteries of 48V-50Ah which according to them, the items were to be imported in 2019 before expiry of the Performance contract (See F.17).


The said list of items approved by TRA in 2015 include the batteries as stated by the company (See. F.11, highlighted items with HS code 850780000000).

Since the application is the normal request of extension of COI, specifically to utilize the approved list of items, in line with the advice given in F.15 (The PVV report from the second team) and the powers given under the Tanzania Investment Act where the EXD *may* extend the period of the project implementation, since Viettel is a strategic Investor who implemented a project for 5 years, I recommend approval of extension of COI by the EXD for one (1) year to allow the company exhaust the list of exempted goods.
