**RE: LETTER OF OFFER TO CONSTRUCT A PERMANENT TENDED CAMP AT  
CASTLE ROCK (NYAMAKIFU) SITE IN RUAHA NATIONAL PARK**

Please refer to the above subject matter

This letter hereby grants permission to The Amelias Safaris to construct a Permanent Tented Camp (PTC) at Castle Rock Site in Ruaha National Park located at GPS Coordinates 70<sup>0</sup> 30 04.17'' S 350 01' 20.82'' E. The facility to be constructed shall have a maximum capacity of 50 beds.

You are therefore required to prepare and submit a Development Prospectus (DP) and Business Plan in line with the TANAPA Revised Investment Policy and Procedures within three months from the date of this letter. Failure to do so, will lead this offer to be revoked and the site will be allocated to another interested party. Once these documents are approved by TANAPA, you will be required to fund an Environmental Impact Assessment study for approval by the National Environmental Management Council (NEMC).

Note that this Offer is only valid for Three Years (3 Years) after which it will be automatically revoked if the site allocated to you has not been developed.

Finally, you will be required to sign a License Agreement with TANAPA as a final stage before starting construction work. The License Agreement with TANAPA is a legal document that stipulates terms and conditions of operation in National Parks.
