Over 200 tonnes barred to enter Kenyan market

TWELVE trucks with maize load, weighing 216 tonnes from Tanzania has been denied entry into Kenya through Hofti Border as drivers and their assistants remain stranded there.

That follows a decision by the Kenya government, through an internal letter from Kenya's Agriculture and Food Authority to the commissioner of customs at the Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) stopping imports of maize into Kenya from Tanzania and Uganda with immediate effect.

The situation at the border resembles the one in the past when truck drivers and their assistants were denied entry to Kenya due to

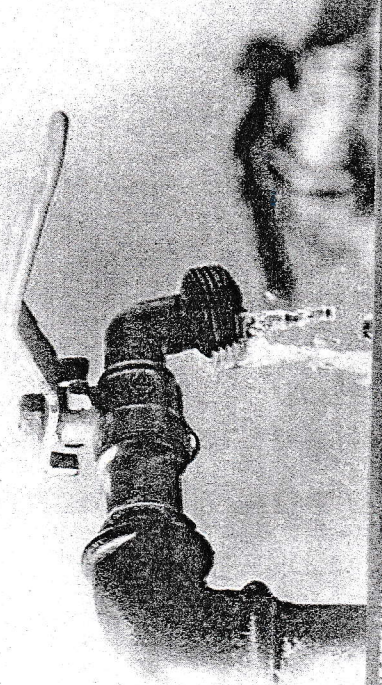

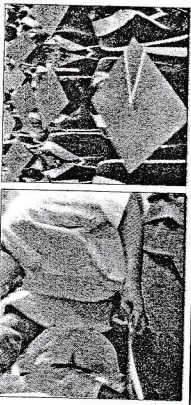
Quality education and clean water and sanitation are in SDGs number four and six respectively and Tanzania is on the right path towards achieving both targets.
