- The name of the company is "NINETY TWO HOTEL LIMITED "
2. The Registered office of the Company will be situated in Tanzania.
3. The objects for which the Company is established are:-
- To acquire and take over as a going concern all the assets and liabilities of the business which was being carried out by the name of **NINETY TWO HOTEL**.
 - To promote tourism in Tanzania and elsewhere in Africa, to carry on business of travel and tourist agents and tour operators, to promote facilitate traveling to organize hunting, tented-camps, fishing and diving expeditions, safari promoters and undertakers generally and in particular to arrange and manager hunting safaris, photo safaris adventure tours, fishing trips, handling of game trophies and animal skins, catching, harbouring, transporting, wildlife and marine products of all kind.
 - To carry on business as safari contractors, organizers and operators and to equip, organize and arrange hunting, photographic, cinematic exploration and cinematographic expeditions and generally to organize and provide facilities for tourist safari adventures of every kind including but not limited to game. Fishing river canoeing, kayaking, and other safaris and expeditions of ever description. Photographers, suppliers and caterers for hunting, fishing, photographic, sight seeing and other expeditions whatsoever.
 - To carry on all or any of the business of transport, carriage and haulage contractors, owners and charter of road vehicles, aircraft and ships and boats of every description and carriers of goods and passenger by road, rail, water or air and to establish, acquire, maintain and operate transport service of every description both public and private and all services ancillary thereto and for such purposes or as independent undertakings to purchase, take in exchange, charter, hire, build, contract or otherwise acquire and to own, operate, work, manage, maintain, repair, service and deal with and in road vehicles, aircraft and vessels of every supplies therefore and to conduct any such business within the country or any other state in Africa or Europe or Asia and or any other foreign country.
 - To carry on the business of big game hunter, trapping and collection of Wild, live birds for sale and export within outside Tanzania, to sell, improved export, and imports, prepare, deal and trade in carvings,

painting, curios, export, and provide game sanctuary facilities and to organize of safaris and expeditions. Discover, hunt, shoot, photograph, capture animals, birds, game and fish of all kinds including reptiles, marine products, pottery crafts, crustacean, salt, mangrove sea shells, groceries, vegetables, cereals goods, fruits and all allied products of every description.

- (f) To engage in and carry out the business of proprietors and managers of food outlet, hotels, restaurants, cafes, road houses, motels, safari and holiday camps, caravan sites, guest houses, apartment housekeepers, refreshment and tea rooms, milk and snacks bars, tavern, beer house and lodging housekeepers and to provide food and catering services to individuals, private and public institutions and to industrial and business concerns.
- (g) To carry on the business of clearing and forwarding agents, commission agents, transporters, freighters, haulers, customs bonded warehouse and godown keepers, cargo and travel agents, insurance agents, tourist agents, manufacturers' representatives, road contractors, cargo superintendents, packers, machinery haulage specialists, warehousemen, engineers, electricians, motor cars, cabs, omnibus, lorries, oil tank and coach proprietors and transporters, civil transport contractor and transporters by any means of conveyance of people and goods in Tanzania and the neighboring countries and in such other place or places as may from time to time be determined by the company, engage in and or otherwise carry on the business as transporters and transport agents, freight forwarders.
- (h) To carry on the business of importers, exports, general merchants, general store-keepers, universal providers, wholesale and/or retail traders, dealers of weighing scales, inkjet technology, moisture analysis, lab equipment, solar technology, hardware, piece wood, paints, glassware, crockery, cutlery, ironmongery, turners and other household fittings and requirements, other articles and commodities of personal, household use and consumption provisions, textiles, groceries, medicines, drugs, wines spirits, liquors, chemical, surgical, option, photographic and other instruments, apparatus and materials, motor vehicles, automobiles and generally in all manufactured goods of all types and merchandise of all kinds.
- (i) To carry on the business as traders, suppliers, general merchants, importers, exporters, stockists, wholesalers, retailers and dealers in all types of electric and electrical goods, hardware, building materials, spare parts and maintenance, tyres, tubes, tools and accessories for all types of automotive, motor vehicles, agricultural machinery, implements, equipment of all kinds of industrial projects machinery and equipment, timber, fishing gears, paints, corrugated iron sheets, hinges, screws, iron mongery, all kinds of ready made garments and used clothes, all types of leather goods, tiles, shoes, bags and other similar goods

- (j) To carry on the business of hospitality and all related hospitality business
- (k) To carry on the business of constructing hotel buildings and use the same for hotel business
- (l) To engage on the business of tourism in all forms and sport tourism activities
- (m) To carry on the business of constructing tourism schools and undertaking the various training and recruiting of all tourism manpower and quality education in tourism such as computer personnel .
- (n) To engage in the business of supplying all tourism and hospitality accessories and equipments
- (o) To carry on the business of import and export of commodities especially cashew shelling machine processing of cashew and exporting the same
- (p) To carry on the business of timber and lumber merchants and saw-mill proprietors and to buy, sell, prepare for market, import, export and deal in timber and wood of all kinds and to manufacture and deal in furniture and / or generally deal in articles of all kinds in the manufacture of which timber or wood is used.
- (q) To carry on the business of farming, agriculture, poultry farming, Dairy farming, poultry breeding farms, Dairy forming, poultry breeding farms, selling and buying chicken feeds, export of meat chickens, broilers, brown egg layers, manufacturing of ghee, cheese, butter and commodities from be-products of milk, farming including banana plantations, coconuts, pineapples, and 11 kinds of fruits and vegetable.
- (r) To carry on the business of Textile Manufacturing such as bed sheets, bedcover, towels, nappies, vikoyi and all kinds of alike, by using weaving handlooms from cotton yarn. Also to deal in Garments manufacturing.
- (s) To develop and turn to account any land acquired by or in which the company is interested and in particular by laying out and preparing the same for building purpose, consulting, altering, pulling down, decorating, maintaining, furnishing, fitting up and improving buildings and planting, paving, draining, farming, cultivating or letting and by advancing Kinda with builders, tenants and others.
- (t) To establish, manage and carry on the trade or business of formers, stock farmers, cattle rearers, grazers, dairymen, livestock and poultry breeders, planters, cultivators, fruit and vegetable growers, fishermen, foresters, hunderts, trappers, fell mongers, tanners, food specialists, preserved meat, fish, fruit, vegetable and food manufacturers, dealers in cattle, sheep and animals general and dealers whether by wholesale or retail in coal, grain, timber, foodstuffs, meat and offal's, hides and skins, fats, tallow, crease

and oils and animal, vegetable and fishery products and by - products, producer and merchandise of all kinds.

- (u) To carry on the business or trade and / or deal in the poultry products, sea shells, sea foods and sea products, shells, prawns, Fresh Fish, lobsters, dried and salted fish, or and generally and kind of pets for sell and export within and outside Tanzania and to Improve, export, import, prepare, deal and trade in Ivory and wooden carvings, paintings, curios, game skins, pottery, leather and leather goods, batiks, wattle banks, coconuts and coconut products, beeswax, meat, butter, cooking oils, charcoal, fence, Poles, wood timber, furniture's, corn, flour fertilizers, cash and food crops or generally to do all or any of the business which is connected with handicrafts and cultural items of every nature and description both by wholesale and retails, by import and export, and transshipment, or same in the capacity of commissions agents and accredited representatives of manufacturers.
- (v) To undertake contracts agreements and tenders on distribution and supply of foodstuffs, vegetables, cooking oils, animal fats, seed oil, fish fat, fruits, fish meat, chicken meat, honey sweets, salts, fruit juices and jellies and also to market, distribute and export same.
- (w) To carry on the business of provisional merchants, stockiest, importers, wholesalers, retailers and dealers in al types of Agricultural Machinery Implements, equipment tyres, spare parts, tools and accessories for all types of automotives motor vehicles and all kinds of industrials and projects machinery equipment.
- (x) To carry on the business of General Merchants and Commission agents, dealers in Textile goods, machinery ready made garments, cements, salt, lime, hardwires, minerals, produce merchants, carpets and piece good merchants, Importers and Exporters, general wholesalers an retail merchants dealers in hosiery, cutlers fancy goods glassware's, enamalloare, branch-ware, jewellery, precious stones, Giffs, Novelties, toys musical instruments, electric goods, cosmetics, land and estate agents, auctioneers, tobacconists, clearing and forwarding agents Insurance agents dealers in petrol lubricants, petroleum products and service station proprietors.
- (y) To engage and carry on the business of reconditioning repairing and servicing of Motor cars, trucks, motor cycles, tractors, trailers and all types of motor vehicles, agricultural and Industrial Machinery and equipments, to engage in the business of and deal in new and second hand motor vehicles, of all description, motor cycles, scooters, agricultural and industrial machinery and equipments, new and second hand spare-parts and accessories for motor vehicles, tractors, trailers and all types of agricultural, industrial machinery, appliances and heavy plants.
- (z) To carry on the business of Textile manufacturers and to establish, erect factories and tailoring houses and to procure all machinery necessary or to

establish such factories and deal in the business of manufacturers of all types of readymade garments for men, women and children.

- (aa) To carry on the business as carrier of goods and passengers, railways, shipping, chartering, forwarding and transporting agents, road contractors, cargo superintendents, packers, haulers, machinery haulage specialists, warehousemen, engineers, electricians, motor cars, cabs, omnibus and coach proprietors, Civil transport contractors and carriers, boat owners, amusement carriers and job masters.
- (bb) To carry on the business of Proprietors and Managers of Hotels, restaurants, cafes, roadhouses, motels, holiday camps, caravan sites, apartment house-keepers, refreshment and tea rooms, milk and snack bars, tavern and beer house and lodging house keepers.
- (cc) To carry on the business of wholesale and / or retail merchants commission agents, brokers, factors, manufacturers representatives (whether local or otherwise) proprietors of Multiple shops, variety chain stores, specialists merchants, super markets and department stores, costumier robe, dress and meant to makers, tailors, silk makers, makers and suppliers of clothing lingerie and trimming of every kind corset makers, furriers, general drippers, haberdashers, milliners, hosiers, glovers, lace makers and dealers, feather dressers and merchants, boots and shoe maker dealers in fabrics and materials of all kinds, ribbons fans, perfumes and flowers (artificial and natural).
- (dd) To carry on the business of importers, dealers and distributors of kerosene, petrol, motor spirit, mineral oil, crude petroleum, lubricating oil, grease and all other kinds of mineral and petroleum products.
- (ee) To engage in and carry on the business of manufacturers of and dealers in all kinds of metal and plastic products, electrical goods textile, garments, printed fabrics clothes, knitwear, personal wear, footwear leather and drubber goods, spare parts and accessories for all types of automotives motor vehicles, machinery, cosmetics, soap perfumes, tea, coffee, cocoa and other food beverages and food products, and the engage in all kinds of industrial and other projects.
- (ff) To carry on the business of transporters by land, sea, air and any other means of convey yanking of people and goods in Tanzania and the neighbourhood and in such other place or places as may from time to time be determined.
- (gg) To carry on the trade or business of plumbers, turners, heating and sanitary engineers, mechanical and diesel engineers, oxyacetylene ore-welder, tank makers, founders, smith machinists, iron masters, steel makers, steel converters, colliery proprietors, template makers and iron founders in all their respective branches.

- (hh) To carry on any other business or activity and to anything of any nature which may seem to the company capable of being conveniently carried on or done in connection with the above or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable or more profitable any of the company's business or property.
- (ii) To take or otherwise acquire and hold shares in any other company having objects altogether or in part similar to those of the company or carrying on any business capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit the company.
- (jj) To purchase, take on lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire any movable or immovable property and any rights or privileges which the company may think necessary or convenient for the purposes of its business and in particular any land, building, easements, machinery, plant and stock-in-trade.
- (kk) To develop any land acquired by the company or in which it is interested and in particular by laying out and preparing the same for building purposes, constructing, altering, pulling down, decorating, maintaining, fitting up and improving buildings, by planting, paving, draining, farming, cultivating and letting on building lease or building agreement and by advancing money to and entering into contracts and arrangements of all kinds with builders and others.
- (ll) To lend money, either with or without security, to such persons or companies, and on such terms as may seem expedient and in particular to customers and others having dealings with the company and to guarantee the performance of contracts by any such persons or companies and generally to give guarantees and indemnities of every description.
- (mm) To borrow or raise or secure the payment of money in such manner as the company shall think fit and in particular by the issue of debentures or debenture stock, perpetual or otherwise, charged upon or secured by a conveyance to trustees or otherwise of all or any of the company's undertaking and property both present and future, including its uncalled capital for the time being and by passing bonds for registration with the proper authority and to purchase, redeem or pay off any such securities.
- (nn) To remunerate any person or company either in cash or by the allotment of shares credited as fully or partly paid up, for services rendered or to be rendered in placing or assisting to place or guaranteeing the placing of any of the shares in the company's capital or any debentures, debenture stock or other securities of the company or in or about the formation or promotion of the company or in or the conduct or development of its business and to pay out of the funds of the company all expenses of and incidental to its formation and registrations.




- (oo) To describe for, conditionally or unconditionally, underwrite, issue on commission or otherwise, take, hold, deal in and convert stocks, shares and securities of all kinds and to promote and aid in promoting, constitute form or organize companies, syndicates or partnership of all kinds for the purpose of acquiring and undertaking any property and liabilities of the company or of advancing, directly or indirectly, the objects thereof or for any other purpose which the company may think expedient.
- (pp) To amalgamate with any other company having objects altogether or in part similar to those of the company.
- (qq) To obtain any order of court or Act for enabling the company to carry any of its objects into effect or for effecting any modification of the company's constitution or for any other purpose which may seem expedient and to oppose any proceedings or applications which may be calculated or seem likely, directly or indirectly to prejudice the company's interests.
- (rr) To establish and support or aid in the establishment and support of associations institutions, funds, trusts and conveniences calculated to benefit employees or ex-employees, directors or ex-directors of the company or its predecessors in business or the dependants or connections of such persons to grant pensions and allowances to make payments towards insurance and to subscribe or guarantee money for charitable or benevolent objects, for any exhibition or for any public general or useful object.

To sell or dispose of the undertaking of the company or any part thereof for such consideration as the company may think fit and in particular for whereas, debentures or securities of any other

In these regulations:-

“The Act” means the Companies Act 2002 of the Laws of Tanzania.

When any provision of the Act is referred to, the reference is that provision is as modified by any law for the time being in force.

Unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions defined in the Act or any statutory modification thereof in the force at the date at which these regulations become binding on the company, shall have the meaning so defined.

Any words importing the singular shall include the plural and vice versa, and words importing the masculine gender shall include females, and the words importing persons shall include bodies corporate, partnership, firms, cooperatives, societies, etc.

The regulations of Companies Act shall not apply to the company, save in so far as they are varied or excluded hereby, but in case of any conflict between the provisions herein, and the provisions under this regulation the former shall prevail, and in addition to substitution shall be the regulations of the company.

PRIVATE COMPANY

2. The Company is a Private Company and accordingly:-
- (a) The right to transfer shares is restricted in manner hereinafter prescribed.
 - (b) The number of members of the company (exclusive of persons who are in the employment of the Company and of persons who have been formerly in the employment of the company were while in such employment to be the member of the company) is limited fifty, provided that where two or more persons hold one or more shares in the company jointly they shall for the purpose of this regulation be tested as a single member.
 - (c) Any invitation to the public to subscribe for any shares or debentures of the Company is prohibited.
 - (d) The Company shall not have power to issue share warrants to bearer.

TRANSFER OF SHARES

3. The Directors may in their direction and without assigning any reason there of refuse to register the transfer of any share to any person who it shall in their opinion be undesirable for any reason whatsoever to admit to membership.
4. Subject to clauses 2 and 3 hereof the right to members to transfer their shares shall be restricted as follows;
 - (a) No share shall be transferred to a person who is not a member so long as any member of any person selected by the Directors as one who it is desirable in the interest of the Company to admit to membership.
 - (b) Every shareholder or trustee in bankruptcy, or any person who may desire to sell or transfer any such shares and every who may desire to sell or transfer any such shares and every personal representatives of a deceased shareholder shall give notice in writing to the Directors that he desires to make such sale or transfer. Such notice shall constitute the Board of Directors of the Company as his agent for the sale of the said shares to any member or members of the company at the price to be agreed upon between the party giving such notice the party and the board, or in case of difference to be determined by the Auditor of the Company.
 - (c) Upon price of such shares being agreed on a determined as per clause (b) above, the board shall forthwith give notice to such of the shareholders other than the shareholders desiring to sell or transfer the said shares, stating the number and price of such share inviting the person to whom notice is sent to state within 21 days from the date of such notice whether he is willing to purchase any, if so what maximum number of such shares. At the expiration of such days 21 notice the board shall apportion such shares amongst the shareholders (if more than one) who shall have expressed their desire to purchase number of shares already held by them respectively, or if there be only one such shareholder, that the whole of such shares shall be sold to him, provided no shareholder shall be obliged to take more than the maximum number of such shares stated in his answer to the said notice.

Upon such apportionment being made or such one shareholder notifying his intention to purchase, as the case may be, the party desiring to sell or transfer such shares shall be bound upon payment of the said price to transfer the shares to the respective shareholders or to single shareholder who shall have agreed to purchase the same.

5. GENERAL MEETINGS: NOTICE OF GENERAL MEETING AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE GENERAL MEETINGS.

The regulation of Companies Act shall apply to the following variations:-

- (a) A General Meeting, Ordinary or Extraordinary may with the consent in writing of all members, be convened on a shorter notice than seven days or without notice.
- (b) Two members, present either personally or by proxy shall form a quorum.
- (c) Any ordinary resolution of the company determined without any general meeting and evidenced by writing under the hands of majority of the Directors and of the members of the company holding three - fourths of the issued shares of the company shall be valid and effectual as an ordinary resolution duly passed at a general meeting of the company.

6. DIRECTORS

- (a) Until otherwise determined by the company in General Meeting the Directors shall not be less than two and not more than four in number.
 - (b) The following persons shall be the first Directors of the company:-
- 7. The shareholding qualification for Directors may be fixed by the company in General Meeting, and unless and until so fixed no qualification shall be required.
 - 8. The quorum of Directors for transacting business shall, unless otherwise fixed by the Directors, be two.
 - 9. A resolution in writing signed by all the Directors then in Tanzania shall be as valid and effectual as if it had been passed at a meeting of Directors duly called and constituted.
 - 10. The Directors may from time to time borrow or raise any money for the purposes of the Company which may exceed the issued share capital of the company.

BORROWING POWERS

The Directors may from time to time in their discretion raise or borrow for the purpose of any Company's business such sum or sums of money as they think fit.

11. The Directors may secure the repayment of or raise any such sum or sums as aforesaid by mortgage or charge upon the whole or any part of the property and assets of the Company present or future including its uncalled capital for the time being, or by the issue at such price as they may think fit, of bonds or debentures either charged upon the whole or any part of the property and assets of the company or not so charged or in such other way as the Directors may think expedient.

VOTE OF MEMBERS

12. On a show of hands every member present in person shall have one vote. On a roll every member shall have one vote only for the shares of which he is holder.
13. No member shall be entitled to vote at any general meeting unless all calls or other sums presently by him in respect of shares in the Company have been paid.

DISQUALIFICATION OF DIRECTORS

14. The office of a Director shall be vacated if the Director;
 - (a) becomes bankrupt; or
 - (b) is found to be a lunatic or becomes of unsound mind; or
 - (c) resigns his office by notice in writing to the Company;
 - (d) abstains himself from meetings of the directors for a period of six months without special leave of absence from the other Directors.

S E A L

15. The Directors shall provide for the safe custody of the Seal. The Seal of the Company shall not be affixed to any instrument except by the authority of a resolution of the Board of Directors and in the presence of at least two Directors or a Director and Secretary or other person as aforesaid shall sign every instrument to which the seal of the Company is so affixed in their presence.

ALTERNATE DIRECTORS

16. Any director shall have power to nominate any person to act or attend as alternate Director during his absence or during his inability so to act. Such Director shall be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions existing with reference to the other Directors and such Alternate Director shall exercise and discharge all the duties of Director whom he represents.
17. Unless otherwise decided by the Directors the quorum necessary to transact business of the Directors shall be two Directors personally present.

SECRETARY

18. The Secretary shall be appointed by the Board for such terms at such remuneration and upon such condition as it may think fit, and any Secretary so appointed may be removed by the Board.

WINDING UP

19. With the sanction of a special resolution of the shareholders any part of the assets of the Company including any shares in other Companies may be divided between the members of the Company in special or may be vested in Trustees for the benefit of such members and the liquidation of the company may be closed and the company dissolved but so that no member shall be compelled to accept any shares whereupon there is any liability.

ALTERNATION OR ADDITION




20. Subject to the provisions of the Act and to those contained in the Memorandum of Association the Company may by Special Resolution make alteration or addition so made shall be as valid and effectual as if originally contained in those articles and be subject in like manner to alteration by Special Resolution.

INDEMNITY

21. Every Director, Managing Director, Agent, Auditor, Secretary and other Officer for the time being of the Company shall be indemnified out of the Assets of the Company against any liability incurred by him in defending any proceedings, whether civil or criminal in which judgement is given in his favour or in which he is acquitted or is in connection with any application in which relief is granted to him by the Court.

ARBITRATION

22. If and whenever any dispute or difference shall arise between the Company and any of the members or their respective representatives touching upon the construction or meaning of any of the Articles herein contained or any act matter or thing made or done or omitted to be done or with regard to the rights or liabilities arising here under or arising out of the relation existing between the parties by reasons of these Articles or the Act, such differences shall (unless a sole arbitrator be agreed upon) forthwith be referred to the arbitration of three (3) arbitrators, one to be appointed by each party and the third to be appointed by the first two or, in the event of failure to agree within (Cap. 15) or any then existing statutory modifications or re-enactment thereof shall apply.
