2. I am pleased to inform you that we have evaluated your submitted Development Prospectus and Architectural Drawings which addressed the relevant sections with explanation as per the TANAPA Tourism Investment Manual (2019-2024).

3. Based on the aforesaid, you are therefore required to carry out an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) study as stipulated in the National Environmental Management Act (2004) under the guidance of the National Environmental Management Council (NEMC) and TANAPA for **EACH OF THE INVESTMENT SITE** that has been allocated to your Company as indicated here.

4. The sites referred here are Nyankoromo Site (GPS Coordinates 36M 0621558 UTM 9752724) in Serengeti National Park for the construction of a Lodge with the maximum of 80 bed capacity, Lamakau Site (GPS Coordinates 37M 0179498 UTM 9536715) in Tarangire National Park for the construction of a Lodge with the maximum of 75 bed capacity, Baghayo Site (GPS Coordinates 36M 0808995 UTM 9613065) in Lake Manyara National Park for the construction of Permanent Tented Camp with the maximum of 40 bed (20 luxury tents) capacity, Nyamakifu Site (GPS Coordinates 37M 0730737 UTM 9166583) in Ruaha National Park for the construction of Permanent Tented Camp with the maximum of 40 bed (20 Luxury tents) capacity and Mgonda Site (GPS Coordinates 37M 0259566 UTM 9638523) in Arusha National Park for the construction of the tourist Lodge with a maximum of 75 bed capacity.

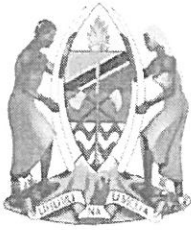
