Please refer to the heading above. I am writing this letter to renew the Certificate of Incentive of Matoborwa Co. Ltd. The company is a food manufacturing company located in Dodoma and had a Certificate of Incentive with reference number No. 042836, which expired on 15 April, 2019.

The company is implementing a project to process and export Tanzanian sweet potatoes to Japan. In the 1st phase of the project, in collaboration with the Tanzanian authorities (TARI), the company conducted trials to introduce two varieties of sweet potatoes from Japan. The varieties then passed the final test for variety registration in 2021.

In the 2nd phase, we aim to expand the scale of the business to make it a profitable enterprise. This will require increasing production facilities, expanding the factory building, and importing vehicles to transport raw materials from contract farmers.

Matoborwa Co. Ltd. will create a new export industry in Tanzania with this project. In addition, the company plans to expand the sales channels of contract farmers and improve their income. To achieve this goal, the company needs the support of the Tanzania Investment Center as Tax exemption for the equipment to be imported to Tanzania.


