MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION
OF
PERFECT TEXTILE INDUSTRY LIMITED

1. The name of the company is "PERFECT TEXTILE INDUSTRY LIMITED"
2. The Registered office of the Company will be situated in Tanzania.
3. The objects for which the Company is established are:-
 - (a) To carry on the business of textile industry, dealing in importing, exporting, marketing, manufacturing stocking, buying, selling whether by wholesale or retail of various categories of goods and merchandise, and to act as commission agents, brokers, insurance agents and manufacturers, representatives in all fields. To be agent of foreign company and to establish business enterprises whether small scale, industries and generally deal in all kinds of general merchants and to import, export and all either by merchandise and articles of all description.
 - (b) To carry on the business as general traders, suppliers, merchants, stockists, wholesalers, retailers and dealers in all types of electrical goods, hardware, building materials, spare parts and maintenance, tyres, tubes, tools and accessories for all types of automotive, motor vehicles, agricultural machinery, implements, equipment, all kinds of industrial projects machinery and equipment, timber, fishing gears, groceries, computers, office equipments, cooking oils, foodstuffs, cosmetics, oils, paints, spirits sheets, hinges, screws, iron mongery, textiles piece goods, all types of leather goods, shoes, bags and other similar goods.
 - (c) To carry on the business and act as managers of investments and investment company, business of property managers, developers, real estate agents valuers, decorators, engineers and to generally be able to carry out activities of any description with regards to land, property and real estate, investment in any type of property, buildings, lands, securities, bonds, shares and any property act as a holding company with subsidiaries and invest in any projects as the company may think fit.
 - (d) To purchase, take or lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire and hold any state or interest in any lands buildings, casements, rights, licenses secret processes, machinery, plants, stock, in trade and real or personal property of any kind.

- (e) To carry on a business of hiring Plant and Equipment, trucks, cars, of all kinds, operating transportations of all kinds including the leasing for any period of number of journey.
- (f) To carry on a business Clearing and Forwarding agents, Tour Operator & Travel agents, Warehousemen Insurance agents, insurance agent, shipping agents, Manufactures agents, and representatives, traders, merchants, auctioneers, wholesalers, importers and exporters, and retails dealers, in articles of all kinds, and to carry on a business of commission Agent of Manufactures agents, Wholesalers and Retailers Traders, Importers and Exporters of merchandise and other procedures of all description
- (g) To acquire, takeover, promote, establish and carry out professional consultancies on Identifying areas in need of attention, Identifying successful practices, Implementing key actions, Sustaining successful approaches or advisory services on organizational performance improvement, management, training of all or any of the private or public companies whose functions include but not limited to human resources planning selection recruitment, courses, job analysis and job evaluation personnel management, modernization of equipment or expansion of institutions, salaries wages, scheme of services, monitoring and appraisal, and organizational structural.
- (h) To provide consultancy services on business, economic, legal, tax and all financial matters.
- (i) To carry on the business of sales, marketing, agents, production, consultants or representatives of foreign or local manufacturers, industries or other like organizations in any type of goods, products, commodities and services.
- (j) To collect and recover loans due to Banks, co-operatives, corporations, companies, public enterprises, parastatals, individuals and to collect employees payments in respect of their claims accruing from salaries, general insurance, pension, PPF, NPF and any other employee payments. To provide security services and assistance in the printing of security documents, civil process serve's loss assessors, possessors, private investigation, property and estate agents commission agents and general security services activities.
- (k) To carry on the business of providing advice on most beneficial method of organizing clients affairs from the tax point of view. Preparing tax computations from accounts adjusted for tax purpose. Dealing with tax assessments levied on clients including tax appeals. Handling all correspondences with Revenue and other tax authorities, Dealing with TRA officials over VAT, maintaining registers of shareholders debenture holders, directors' shareholding, charges and other statutory books.

- (l) To provide agricultural consultations, initiate projects, offer managerial service, technical services and performance evaluation, training, research and advisory services to farmers and livestock keepers through seminars, workshops field visits and farm demonstrations, to engage in vegetables seed production and marketing of horticultural products, to carry on the business of farming, cultivating, planting growing cash and food crops, inter alia, sugar cane, tea, coffee, cocoa, coconut, papaya and pyrethrum.
- (m) To engage in marketing, promotion, consultancy, advertising, telecommunication equipment and contractual jobs regarding cellular operations, services and surveys, professional publishers, producers of newspapers, bulletins, journals, periodicals, magazines, programmer, advertisements, to be promoters and financiers of publicity and/or publications, newsagents, to offer and or render communication services, transportation facilities, telephones, telex, telefax, audio visual films, to be news collectors, editors, disseminators, television, radio broadcasting, buyers, sellers, importers, distributors, suppliers of all kinds of photographic equipments, story books and or booklets, pictorial albums, to be consultants, promoters, financiers and participants in either industrial commercial projects both nationally and internationally.
- (n) To establish and operate conference centers for local and international meetings, amusement caterers and organizers and of proprietors, providers, organizer and managers of all kinds of both public and private entertainment, amusements, recreations and sports, whether outdoor or indoor including exhibitions, competitions, games, tournaments, concerts, dances, television performance, variety shows and other types of like enterprises generally.
- (o) To carry on the business as team relocation, concierge, preparing business plan, proposals, projects to the entrepreneurs, group, organizations and companies.
- (p) To train, appraise, coach, search for, solicit, interview, select, recruit and place individuals as well as offer job analysis, advertising, searching, recruitment and placement, legal drafting, legal opinion, legal advising services to any entity, natural or otherwise.
- (q) To undertake the business of soliciting clients in providing recruitment agency services including, analyzing a client's current and proposed positions, present and potential, job analyses, developing company competencies and related behaviours, candidate database searches, advertising searches, advertising vacancies, headhunting, screening and interviewing candidates and employing other section tools generally.

- (r) To perform such other services as a client may request from time to time such as, but not limited to, direct approach recruitment (target recruitment). Training programs, labour market research and analysis.
- (s) To carry on the business of preparing books of accounts to small and medium enterprises as targeted group of customers but also all organizations and companies at large. Stock taking or physical counting of stock, goods or products.
- (t) To promote self-reliance for entrepreneurs groups by providing various techniques of exploring the existing opportunities.
- (u) To provide of seminars, workshops with a view of training and educating the entrepreneur groups, organizations, business and their products.
- (v) To use the computer facilities available, hired or owned, for evaluating, appraising, ranking or otherwise analyzing investment proposed by the Company or any of its clients, and to act as expert witnesses, funds negotiation, litigation, presentation or in any way whatsoever so as to meet the client's requirements and in all the company areas of business or expertise.
- (w) To conduct auditing, tax assessment, preparation of financial accounting and other related works.
- (x) To deal in the business of project management, consultancy and or otherwise dealing in specialized events management, social concert like wedding organize, employments agents, but not limiting to the deal in the micro financing and importing of related project tools and applications and to serve them in domestic or export market and to carry out various activities incidental to the attainment of the main object as contained in this clause, whether done for gain or otherwise.
- (y) To use the computer facilities available, hired or owned, for evaluating, appraising, ranking or otherwise analyzing investment proposed by the Company or any of its clients, and to act as expert witnesses, funds negotiation, litigation, presentation or in any way whatsoever so as to meet the client's requirements and in all the company areas of business or expertise.
- (z) To carry on the business of media and entertainment, media communication and consultancy advertising agents, advertising, public relations, consultants and sales promotion consultants in all their aspects and to advise on publicity, sales promotion, staff relations, industrial relation, press and community relations. To conduct and advise on market research, publicity projects, advertising campaigns, exhibitions, trade fairs, exhibitions and trade fairs consultation, displays, film shows, radio and television programmes, and also to carry on the business of investment advisers, market research and to act as intermediaries in the introduction of sellers, purchasers and partners.

- (aa) To advise on public relations, publicity, advertising point of sale contacts with the public, sales promotion, staff relations, industrial relations, management relations, press relations, employee relations, stockholders relations and community relations specifically in Africa but also in other parts of the world.
- (bb) To carry on the business as general distributors of all sorts and types of products and services to individuals, offices, industries, shops, schools, factories, hospitals, army, military, ministries and all other government offices, universities and all other places where the services of a supplier are needed.
- (cc) To carry on the business of importers, exporters, buying selling, dealers in hardware, building materials, sanitary-ware, wall papers, roofing tiles, flooring tiles, supplying industrial equipment's agricultural implements and equipment's spares of every description, plumbers, decorators, steel fabrication, machine shop, nickel plating, electric plating, making steel windows, doors, frames and roof tresses.
- (dd) To carry on the business as importers and distributors of all kinds of mining equipments whatever description.
- (ee) To carry on the business of establishing and running supermarkets, department stores, shopping malls, provision stores, groceries and shops of all kinds and description and generally to deal with such activities.
- (ff) To carry on the business of marketing, services, consultancy and selling of all types of telecommunication systems, information technologies, computer systems, conference systems, security systems, public address systems, data communication and to train, research, install and after sale services of electronic systems, voice and data networks and any other systems or components which the company may think fit, necessary or incidental to this business.
- (gg) To carry on the business of household, domestic appliance and electrical goods, electronic items, audio visual goods, building material, hardwares, foodstuff, agricultural products and merchandise of every nature, kind and description whatsoever as a dealer, wholesaler, retailer, distributor, importer, exporter and after sales service and repairing.
- (hh) To carry on the business as manufacturers, principals or agents representatives of importing, exporting, buying, selling, distributing of new and used motor vehicles, cars, trucks, lorries or other vehicles, motor vehicles spares and parts of all descriptions, railway, fuel and other oils, petroleum of all kinds, tyres and tubes, batteries, battery solution and other spares, accessories, motor cycles, bicycles, tractors, mining equipments, fishing gears, agricultural and industrial machinery

and equipments, new and second hand spare parts and accessories and generally to deal in all types of motor spare parts and industrial and agricultural machinery and parts, electronic goods and accessories thereof.

- (ii) To carry on the business as exporters, traders, suppliers, general merchants, stockists, wholesalers, retailers and dealers in business of scrapers, agricultural machinery, implements, equipment and all kinds of industrial projects machinery.
- (jj) To carry on the business of wholesalers, retailers, general traders, suppliers, merchants, importers, exporters, stockists and dealers in all types of bags, shoes, clothes, textile materials, tie and dye, boutique, caps, selling second hand clothing, dresses of types and description whatsoever.
- (kk) To advance money to any person or persons or corporations, either with or without interest upon the security of freehold or leasehold property by way of mortgage, or upon marketable security and in particular to advance money to shareholders in the company, and others, upon the security of or for the purpose of enabling the person borrowing the same to effect or purchase, or enlarge or repair any house of building or to purchase the free simple or any term or terms of years of any property in Tanzania, or elsewhere upon such terms, and conditions as the Company may think fit.
- (ll) To engage in and carry out the business of proprietors and managers of hotels, restaurants, cafes, road houses, motels, safari and holiday camps, caravan sites, guest houses, apartment housekeepers, refreshment and tea rooms, milk and snacks bars, tavern, beer house and lodging housekeepers and to provide food and catering services to individuals, private and public institutions and to industrial and business concerns.
- (mm) To purchase, take on lease and otherwise acquire for investment or resale any estate, land, buildings, easements and other rights and interests in immovable property or any tenure in Tanzania and elsewhere and to sell let or lease exchange or otherwise dispose of or grant rights over any immovable property, belong to the company.
- (nn) To accept payment for any property or rights sold or otherwise disposed or dealt with by the company either in cash, by installment or otherwise or in fully or partly paid up shares of the company or corporation, with or without deferred or preferred or guaranteed rights.
- (oo) To carry any other trade or business whatever which can in the opinion of the Board of Directors be advantageously carried on by the Company

in connection with the above business or the general business of the company.

- (pp) To act as agents for the sale and purchase of any stocks shares or securities or for any other monetary or mercantile transactions.
- (qq) To act as executors and trustees of wills and settlements made by customers and others and undertake and execute trusts of all kinds.
- (rr) To do all or any of the above things in any part of the world and either as principals, agents, trustees, contractors or otherwise, and either alone or in conjunction with others and either or though agents, sub-contractors, trustees and otherwise.
- (ss) To remunerate any person, firm or company rendering services to this company, whether by cash payments or by allotment to him or them of shares or securities of the Company credited and paid in full or in part, otherwise.
- (tt) To accept for safe custody and keep for customers of the company all kinds of securities valuables and things.
- (uu) To lend money on any terms that may thought fit, and particularly to customers or other person or corporations having dealing with societies and to give any guarantees that may be expedient.
- (vv) To advance money to shareholders in the company, and other to the purpose of enabling the person borrowing the same erect or purchase, or enlarge or repair any house or building or to purchase the fee simple or any less estate or interest in, or to take a demise for any term or terms of years of any freehold or leasehold property upon such terms and conditions as the company may think fit.
- (ww) To invest and deal with the moneys of the Company not immediately required, upon such securities and in such manner as may from time to time be determined.
- (xx) To distribute among the members in pieces any property of the company, or any proceeds of sale or disposal of any property of the company.
- (yy) To draw, make, accept, endorse, discount execute and issue promissory notes, bills of lading, warrants, debentures and negotiable or transferable instruments.
- (zz) To act as agents or brokers, and as trustees for any person firm or company, and to undertake and perform sub-contracts and also to act in any other business of the company through or by means of agents, brokers, sub-contractors or others.

- (aaa) To obtain any provisional order, ordinance or act of Parliament for enabling the Company to carry any of its objects into effect, or for affecting any modification of the Company's constitution, or any other purpose which may seem expedient, and to oppose any proceedings or applications which may seem calculated, directly or indirectly to prejudice the company's interest.
- (bbb) To take or otherwise and hold shares in any other company having objects altogether or in part similar to this company, or carrying on any business capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit the company.
- (ccc) To transact or carry on all kinds of Agency business and in particular in relation to the investment of money, the sale of property, and the collection and receipt of money.
- (ddd) To do all other things as may be deemed incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects or any of them.

And it is hereby declared that:-

The word "company" in this clause, except where used in reference to this Company, shall be deemed to include any partnership or other body of persons, whether corporate or incorporate, and whether domiciled in the United Republic of Tanzania or elsewhere.



The object specified in each of the paragraphs of the paragraph of this clause shall be regarded as independent objects, and accordingly shall in no way be limited or restricted (except where otherwise expressed in such paragraphs) by reference to or inference from the terms of any other paragraph of the name of the Company but may be carried out in as full and ample a manner and construed in as wide a sense as if each of the said paragraphs define the objects of the separate and distinct compound.

That the meaning of any general word or words in any paragraph of this clause shall not be restricted by being construed ejusdem generis with any particular word or words in the same paragraph.

- 4. The Liability of the Members is Limited.
- 5. The capital of the Company is Shillings 100,000,000/= divided into 1,000 shares of Shillings 100,000/= each.

The Company shall have powers to increase its capital and to divide the shares in its capital for the time being into several classes of stock or shares and to attach thereto respectively such preferential, deferred or special rights, privileges, or conditions as may be determined by or in accordance with the Articles of Association of the Company.

We, the several persons whose names and addresses are subscribed, are desirous of being formed into a company, in pursuance of this Memorandum of Association, and we respectively agree to take the number of shares in the capital of the Company set opposite our respective names.

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

OF

PERFECT TEXTILE INDUSTRY LIMITED

PRELIMINARY

1. In these regulations:-

“The Act” means the Companies Act 2002 of the Laws of Tanzania.

When any provision of the Act is referred to, the reference is that provision is as modified by any law for the time being in force.

Unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions defined in the Act or any statutory modification thereof in the force at the date at which these regulations become binding on the company, shall have the meaning so defined.

Any words importing the singular shall include the plural and vice versa, and words importing the masculine gender shall include females, and the words importing persons shall include bodies corporate, partnership, firms, cooperatives, societies, etc.

The regulations of Companies Act shall not apply to the company, save in so far as they are varied or excluded hereby, but in case of any conflict between the provisions herein, and the provisions under this regulation the former shall prevail, and in addition to substitution shall be the regulations of the company.

PRIVATE COMPANY

2. The Company is a Private Company and accordingly:-

- (a) The right to transfer shares is restricted in manner hereinafter prescribed.
- (b) The number of members of the company (exclusive of persons who are in the employment of the Company and of persons who have been formerly in the employment of the company were while in such employment to be the member of the company) is limited fifty, provided that where two or more persons hold one or more shares in the company jointly they shall for the purpose of this regulation be tested as a single member.
- (c) Any invitation to the public to subscribe for any shares or debentures of the Company is prohibited.
- (d) The Company shall not have power to issue share warrants to bearer.

TRANSFER OF SHARES

3. The Directors may in their direction and without assigning any reason thereof refuse to register the transfer of any share to any person who it shall in their opinion be undesirable for any reason whatsoever to admit to membership.
4. Subject to clauses 2 and 3 hereof the right to members to transfer their shares shall be restricted as follows;
 - (a) No share shall be transferred to a person who is not a member so long as any member of any person selected by the Directors as one who it is desirable in the interest of the Company to admit to membership.
 - (b) Every shareholder or trustee in bankruptcy, or any person who may desire to sell or transfer any such shares and every who may desire to sell or transfer any such shares and every personal representatives of a deceased shareholder shall give notice in writing to the Directors that he desires to make such sale or transfer. Such notice shall constitute the Board of Directors of the Company as his agent for the sale of the said shares to any member or members of the company at the price to be agreed upon between the party giving such notice the party and the board, or in case of difference to be determined by the Auditor of the Company.
 - (c) Upon price of such shares being agreed on a determined as per clause (b) above, the board shall forthwith give notice to such of the shareholders other than the shareholders desiring to sell or transfer the said shares, stating the number and price of such share inviting the person to whom notice is sent to state within 21 days from the date of such notice whether he is willing to purchase any, if so what maximum number of such shares. At the expiration of such days 21 notice the board shall apportion such shares amongst the shareholders (if more than one) who shall have expressed their desire to purchase number of shares already held by them respectively, or if there be only one such shareholder, that the whole of such shares shall be sold to him, provided no shareholder shall be obliged to take more than the maximum number of such shares stated in his answer to the said notice.

Upon such apportionment being made or such one shareholder notifying his intention to purchase, as the case may be, the party desiring to sell or transfer such shares shall be bound upon payment of the said price to transfer the shares to the respective shareholders or to single shareholder who shall have agreed to purchase the same.

5. **GENERAL MEETINGS: NOTICE OF GENERAL MEETING AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE GENERAL MEETINGS.**

The regulation of Companies Act shall apply to the following variations:-

- (a) A General Meeting, Ordinary or Extraordinary may with the consent in writing of all members, be convened on a shorter notice than seven days or without notice.
- (b) Two members, present either personally or by proxy shall form a quorum.
- (c) Any ordinary resolution of the company determined without any general meeting and evidenced by writing under the hands of majority of the Directors and of the members of the company holding three - fourths of the issued shares of the company shall be valid and effectual as an ordinary resolution duly passed at a general meeting of the company.

6. DIRECTORS

- (a) Until otherwise determined by the company in General Meeting the Directors shall not be less than two and not more than four in number.
 - (b) The following persons shall be the first Directors of the company:-
 - 1. YANG FEN
 - 2. WANG LIANGYING
7. The shareholding qualification for Directors may be fixed by the company in General Meeting, and unless and until so fixed no qualification shall be required.
8. The quorum of Directors for transacting business shall, unless otherwise fixed by the Directors, be three.
9. A resolution in writing signed by all the Directors then in Tanzania shall be as valid and effectual as if it had been passed at a meeting of Directors duly called and constituted.
10. The Directors may from time to time borrow or raise any money for the purposes of the Company which may exceed the issued share capital of the company.

BORROWING POWERS

- 11. The Directors may from time to time in their discretion raise or borrow for the purpose of any Company's business such sum or sums of money as they think fit.
- 12. The Directors may secure the repayment of or raise any such sum or sums as aforesaid by mortgage or charge upon the whole or any part of the property and assets of the Company present or future including its uncalled capital for the time being, or by the issue at such price as they may think fit, of bonds or debentures either charged upon the whole or

any part of the property and assets of the company or not so charged or in such other way as the Directors may think expedient.

VOTE OF MEMBERS

12. On a show of hands every member present in person shall have one vote. On a roll every member shall have one vote only for the shares of which he is holder.
13. No member shall be entitled to vote at any general meeting unless all calls or other sums presently by him in respect of shares in the Company have been paid.

DISQUALIFICATION OF DIRECTORS

14. The office of a Director shall be vacated if the Director;
 - (a) becomes bankrupt; or
 - (b) is found to be a lunatic or becomes of unsound mind; or
 - (c) resigns his office by notice in writing to the Company;
 - (d) abstains himself from meetings of the directors for a period of six months without special leave of absence from the other Directors.

S E A L

15. The Directors shall provide for the safe custody of the Seal. The Seal of the Company shall not be affixed to any instrument except by the authority of a resolution of the Board of Directors and in the presence of at least two Directors or a Director and Secretary or other person as aforesaid shall sign every instrument to which the seal of the Company is so affixed in their presence.

ALTERNATE DIRECTORS

16. Any director shall have power to nominate any person to act or attend as alternate Director during his absence or during his inability so to act. Such Director shall be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions existing with reference to the other Directors and such Alternate Director shall exercise and discharge all the duties of Director whom he represents.
17. Unless otherwise decided by the Directors the quorum necessary to transact business of the Directors shall be two Directors personally present.

SECRETARY

18. The Secretary shall be appointed by the Board for such terms at such remuneration and upon such condition as it may think fit, and any Secretary so appointed may be removed by the Board.

WINDING UP

19. With the sanction of a special resolution of the shareholders any part of the assets of the Company including any shares in other Companies may be divided between the members of the Company in special or may be vested in Trustees for the benefit of such members and the liquidation of the company may be closed and the company dissolved but so that no member shall be compelled to accept any shares whereupon there is any liability.

ALTERNATION OR ADDITION

20. Subject to the provisions of the Act and to those contained in the Memorandum of Association the Company may by Special Resolution make alteration or addition so made shall be as valid and effectual as if originally contained in those articles and be subject in like manner to alteration by Special Resolution.



INDEMNITY

21. Every Director, Managing Director, Agent, Auditor, Secretary and other Officer for the time being of the Company shall be indemnified out of the Assets of the Company against any liability incurred by him in defending any proceedings, whether civil or criminal in which judgement is given in his favour or in which he is acquitted or is in connection with any application in which relief is granted to him by the Court.

ARBITRATION

22. If and whenever any dispute or difference shall arise between the Company and any of the members or their respective representatives touching upon the construction or meaning of any of the Articles herein contained or any act matter or thing made or done or omitted to be done or with regard to the rights or liabilities arising here under or arising out of the relation existing between the parties by reasons of these Articles or the Act, such differences shall (unless a sole arbitrator be agreed upon) forthwith be referred to the arbitration of three (3) arbitrators, one to be appointed by each party and the third to be appointed by the first two or, in the event of failure to agree within

(Cap. 15) or any then existing statutory modifications or re-enactment thereof shall apply.


