MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

OF

MAKUNDI TRANSPORT & GENERAL SUPPLIES LIMITED

1. The name of the company "MAKUNDI TRANSPORT & GENERAL SUPPLIES LIMITED
2. The Registered office of the Company will be situated in Tanzania.
3. The objects for which the Company is established are:-
 - (a) To acquire and take over as a going concern the business carried now under the name and style of MAKUNDI TRANSPORT & GENERAL SUPPLIES with all its assets and liabilities and to carry on all or any of the business of transport, carriage and haulage contractors, owners and charter of road vehicles, aircraft and ships and boats of every description and carriers of goods and passenger by road, rail, water or air and to establish, acquire, maintain and operate transport service of every description both public and private and all services ancillary thereto and for such purposes or as independent undertakings to purchase, take in exchange, charter, hire, build, contract or otherwise acquire and to own, operate, work, manage, maintain, repair, service and deal with and in road vehicles, aircraft and vessels of every supplies therefore and to conduct any such business within the country or any other state in Africa or Europe or Asia and or any other foreign country.
 - (b) To carry on the business as general suppliers of all sorts and types of goods and services to schools, individuals, offices, industries, shops, factories, hospitals, army, military, ministries and all other government offices, universities and all other places where the services of a supplier are needed.
 - (c) To carry on the business of dealing in importing, exporting, marketing, manufacturing stocking, buying, selling whether by wholesale or retail of various categories of goods and merchandise, and to act as commission agents, brokers, insurance agents and manufacturers, representatives in all fields. To establish business enterprises whether small scale, industries and generally deal in all kinds of general merchants and to import, export and all either by merchandise and articles of all description.
 - (d) To carry on the business of clearing and forwarding agents, commission agents, transporters, freighters, hauliers, customs bonded warehouse and godown keepers, cargo and travel agents, insurance agents, tourist agents, manufacturers' representatives, road contractors, cargo superintendents, packers, machinery haulage specialists, warehousemen, engineers, electricians, motor cars, cabs, omnibus, lorries, oil tank and coach proprietors and transporters, civil transport contractors and transporters by any other means of conveyance of

people and goods in Tanzania and the neighbouring countries and in such other place or places as may from time to time be determined by the company, engage in and or otherwise carry on the business as transporters and transport agents, freight forwarders.

- (e) To carry on all business pertaining to International Shipping Agency in the Republic of Tanzania, East and Central Africa, south and North Africa and other Countries of Africa either as Principles or Agents. To open branches and carry on such mentioned business in any part of the world which is not a hostile country. To amalgamate, sell the Agency, enter into joint venture or merge either vertically or horizontally with any other business or company whatsoever.
- (f) To engage in and carry out the business of proprietors and managers of hotels, restaurants, cafes, road houses, motels, safari and holiday camps, caravan sites, guest houses, apartment housekeepers, refreshment and tea rooms, milk and snacks bars, tavern, beer house and lodging housekeepers and to provide food and catering services to individuals, private and public institutions and to industrial and business concerns.
- (g) To carry on all their respective branches all or any of the business of builders masonry and general construction contractors and haulers and among other things to construct, execute, carry out, equip, improve, work and advertise railways, roadways, tramways, docks, harbours, wharves, canals, water-courses, reservoirs, embankments, irrigations, reclamations, sewage, drainage and other sanitary works, water, gas, mechanic, electric and other supply works, houses buildings and erections of every kind and to carry on any other business in connection with the above mentioned business.
- (h) To engage in and or otherwise carry on the business of environmental protection and management, financial management, sanitary services, super cleaners, removal treatment contractors, rural, urban and community centers cleaners, landscapers to be professional sanitary services contractors, promoters of health services in governmental departments, offices, companies, public or private institutions, individual and any other organization all over the world.
- (i) To carry on the business of importers, exporters, buying selling, dealers in hardware, building materials, sanitary-ware, wall papers, roofing tiles, flooring tiles, supplying industrial equipment's agricultural implements and equipment's spares of every description, plumbers, decorators, steel fabrication, machine shop, nickel plating, electric plating, making steel windows, doors, frames and roof tresses and to consultancy on proper housing.
- (j) To engage in and or otherwise carry on the business of civil works, civil engineering, road constructions, buildings, renovations, office partitioners, decoratories, maintainers of dilapidated buildings,

plumbing, furniture manufacturers, suppliers and exporters, residential and office furnishers and general to be designers and fabricators, rehabilitation of all kinds of gadgets whatsoever, to be timber processors, sawmillers and suppliers of all kinds of timber, to be hardware and building materials suppliers, manufactures of electrical equipments and suppliers of same.

- (k) To promote tourism in Tanzania and elsewhere in Africa, to carry on business of travel and tourist agents and tour operators, car hire/rental, to promote facilitate traveling to organise hunting, tented-camps, fishing and diving expeditions, safari promoters and undertakers generally and in particular to arrange and manager hunting safaris, photo safaris adventure tours, fishing trips, handling of game trophies and animal skins, catching, harbouring, transporting, wildlife and marine products of all kind.
- (l) To carry on the business of designing and developing real estates whether single or multi storey building, mansionnette and the like for the purpose of outright sales to the like for the purpose of outright sales to the public.
- (m) To carry on the business as general traders, wholesalers, retailers suppliers, merchants, stockists, and dealers in all types of spare parts and maintenance, tyres, tubes, tools and accessories for all types of automotive, motor vehicles, agricultural machinery, implements, equipment, all kinds of industrial projects machinery and equipment, electrical goods, hardware, building materials, timber, fishing gears, groceries, computers, office equipments, cooking oils, salts, foodstuffs, cosmetics, oils, paints, spirits sheets, hinges, screws, iron mongery, textiles piece goods, all types of leather goods, shoes, bags and other similar goods.
- (n) To carry on the business of warehousemen, godown keepers and storers of goods, wares and merchandise of every kind and description and whatsoever.
- (o) To carry on the business of garage proprietors and service station for motor vehicles of all kinds, to carry on the safe keeping, cleaning, repairing, servicing, refueling, panel beating, body builders, spraying and the general care of motor vehicles, aircraft, machinery, tools, equipment and plant whether moved by mechanical power or not, implements, utensils, appliances, apparatus, fuel for internal combustion engines, lubricants, cements, solutions, batteries and accessories and all things capable of being used in connection with the said businesses or in the manufacture or maintenance of such vehicles, machinery, equipment and plant.
- (p) To carry on the business as principals, agents or manufacturers, representatives of importing, exporting, buying, selling, distributing of motor vehicles, cars, trucks, lorries or other vehicles, motor vehicles,

railway spares and parts of all descriptions, fuel and other oils, petroleum of all kinds, tyres and tubes, batteries, battery solution and other spares, accessories, motor cycles, bicycles, tractors, mining equipments, fishing gears, agricultural and industrial machinery and equipments, new and second hand spare parts and accessories and generally to deal in all types of motor spare parts and industrial and agricultural machinery and parts, electronic goods and accessories thereof.

- (q) To carry on the business of establishing and running supermarkets, department stores, shopping malls, provision stores, groceries and shops of all kinds and description and generally to deal with such activities
- (r) To engage in investment scheme for construction, rehabilitation, erection, ownership and management of commercial buildings, export processing zones and special economic zones, to buy, sell, hire, manufacture, trade, and deal in property, goods, produce, articles, and merchandise of all kinds and transact any and every description as development agency, distribution, marketing, commercial, industrial, manufacturing, mercantile, insurance and financial business and carry on the business of traders, general merchants, general storekeepers, metals, commission agents, business consultants, market research consultants, business transfer agents, company promoters, underwriters, financiers and bill brokers, del-credere agents, barter traders, court brokers, auctioneers and generally to execute and undertake agencies of all kind or carry on the business of warehouse construction, landscaping, engineering, general civil works and deal in all kinds of scrap metal and precious metals.
- (s) To carry on the business of traders, general merchants, commission agents, manufacturers representatives and to buy, sell, hire, manufacture, barter, trade and deal in property, mechanical machine shop, spare parts and machinery of every description, goods and articles and merchandise of all kinds and to transact any and every description of agency, commission, distribution, marketing, commercial, industrial, manufacturing, merchantile, insurance and financial business.
- (t) To carry on the business of marketing, services, consultancy and selling of all types of information technologies, computer systems, conference systems, telecommunication systems, security systems, public address systems, data communication and to train, research, install and after sale services of electronic systems, voice and data networks and any other systems or components which the company may think fit, necessary or incidental to this business.
- (u) To carry on the business of miners and mining in all their branches and for the said purpose to peg, purchase, take on lease, or exchange or otherwise acquire concessions, grants, easements, options, claims, properties, cassettes- and effects supposed to contain minerals, diamonds, or other precious stones, and any interest therein, and to

explore, mine, work, excise develop and turn to account mines and mining rights and any undertaking connected therewith.

- (v) To carry on all or any business of printing, publishing, distributing and selling of business, management, industrial, scientific, academic, communications, financial, agricultural, social and environmental information technology periodicals, brochures and books and any other reading materials.
- (w) To purchase, take on lease and otherwise acquire for investment or resale any estate, land, buildings, easements and other rights and interests in immovable property or any tenure in Tanzania and elsewhere and to sell let or lease exchange or otherwise dispose of or grant rights over any immovable property, belong to the company.
- (x) To purchase, take or lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire and hold any state or interest in any lands buildings, casements, rights, licenses secret processes, machinery, plants, stock, in trade and real or personal property of any kind.
- (y) To accept payment for any property or rights sold or otherwise disposed or dealt with by the company either in cash, by installment or otherwise or in fully or partly paid up shares of the company or corporation, with or without deferred or preferred or guaranteed rights.
- (z) To carry any other trade or business whatever which can in the opinion of the Board of Directors be advantageously carried on by the Company in connection with the above business or the general business of the company.
- (aa) To act as agents for the sale and purchase of any stocks shares or securities or for any other monetary or mercantile transactions.
- (bb) To act as executors and trustees of wills and settlements made by customers and others and undertake and execute trusts of all kinds.
- (cc) To do all or any of the above things in any part of the world and either as principals, agents, trustees, contractors or otherwise, and either alone or in conjunction with others and either or though agents, sub-contractors, trustees and otherwise.
- (dd) To remunerate any person, firm or company rendering services to this company, whether by cash payments or by allotment to him or them of shares or securities of the Company credited and paid in full or in part, otherwise.
- (ee) To accept for safe custody and keep for customers of the company all kinds of securities valuables and things.

- (ff) To lend money on any terms that may thought fit, and particularly to customers or other person or corporations having dealing with societies and to give any guarantees that may be expedient..
- (gg) To advance money to shareholders in the company, and other to the purpose of enabling the person borrowing the same erect or purchase, or enlarge or repair any house or building or to purchase the fee simple or any less estate or interest in, or to take a demise for any term or terms of years of any freehold or leasehold property upon such terms and conditions as the company may think fit.
- (hh) To invest and deal with the moneys of the Company not immediately required, upon such securities and in such manner as may from time to time be determined.
- (ii) To distribute among the members in pieces any property of the company, or any proceeds of sale or disposal of any property of the company.
- (jj) To draw, make, accept, endorse, discount execute and issue promissory notes, bills of lading, warrants, debentures and negotiable or transferable instruments.
- (kk) To act as agents or brokers, and as trustees for any person firm or company, and to undertake and perform sub-contracts and also to act in any other business of the company through or by means of agents, brokers, sub-contractors or others.
- (ll) To obtain any provisional order, ordinance or act of Parliament for enabling the Company to carry any of it is objects into effect, or for affecting any modification of the Company's constitution, or any other purpose which may seem expedient, and to oppose any proceedings or applications which may seem calculated, directly or indirectly to prejudice the company's interest.
- (mm) To take or otherwise and hold shares in any other company having objects altogether or in part similar to this company, or carrying on any business capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit the company.
- (nn) To transact or carry on all kinds of Agency business and in particular in relation to the investment of money, the sale of property, and the collection and receipt of money.
- (oo) To do all other things as may be deemed incidental or conducive to the entertainment of the objects or any of them.

And it is hereby declared that:-

The word "company" in this clause, except where used in reference to this Company, shall be deemed to include any partnership or other body

of persons, whether corporate or incorporate, and whether domiciled in the United Republic of Tanzania or elsewhere.

The object specified in each of the paragraphs of the paragraph of this clause shall be regarded as independent objects, and accordingly shall in no way be limited or restricted (except where otherwise expressed in such paragraphs) by reference to or inference from the terms of any other paragraph of the name of the Company but may be carried out in as full and ample a manner and construed in as wide a sense as if each of the said paragraph define the objects of the separate and distinct compound.

That the meaning of any general word or words in any paragraph of this clause shall not be restricted by being construed *ejusdem generis* with any particular word or words in the same paragraph.

4. The Liability of the Members is Limited.
5. The capital of the Company is Shillings 100,000,000/= divided into 10,000 shares of Shillings 10,000/= each.

The Company shall have powers to increase its capital and to divide the shares in its capital for the time being into several classes of stock or shares and to attach thereto respectively such preferential, deferred or special rights, privileges, or conditions as may be determined by or in accordance with the Articles of Association of the Company.

We, the several persons whose names and addresses are subscribed, are desirous of being formed into a company, in pursuance of this Memorandum of Association, and we respectively agree to take the number of shares in the capital of the Company set opposite our respective names.

THE COMPANIES ACT 2002
COMPANY LIMITED BY SHARES
ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

OF

MAKUNDI TRANSPORT & GENERAL SUPPLIES LIMITED

PRELIMINARY

1. In these regulations:-
"The Act" means the Companies Act 2002 of the Laws of Tanzania.

When any provision of the Act is referred to, the reference is that provision is as modified by any law for the time being in force.

Unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions defined in the Act or any statutory modification thereof in the force at the date at which these regulations become binding on the company, shall have the meaning so defined.

Any words importing the singular shall include the plural and vice versa, and words importing the masculine gender shall include females, and the words importing persons shall include bodies corporate, partnership, firms, cooperatives, societies, etc.

The regulations of Companies Act shall not apply to the company, save in so far as they are varied or excluded hereby, but in case of any conflict between the provisions herein, and the provisions under this regulation the former shall prevail, and in addition to substitution shall be the regulations of the company.

PRIVATE COMPANY

2. The Company is a Private Company and accordingly:-
 - (a) The right to transfer shares is restricted in manner hereinafter prescribed.
 - (b) The number of members of the company (exclusive of persons who are in the employment of the Company and of persons who have been formerly in the employment of the company were while in such employment to be the member of the company) is limited fifty, provided that where to or

more persons hold one or more shares in the company jointly they shall for the purpose of this regulation be tested as a single member.

- (c) Any invitation to the public to subscribe for any shares or debentures of the Company is prohibited.
- (d) The Company shall not have power to issue share warrants to bearer.

TRANSFER OF SHARES

- 3. The Directors may in their direction and without assigning any reason thereof refuse to register the transfer of any share to any person who it shall in their opinion be undesirable for any reason whatsoever to admit to membership.
- 4. Subject to clauses 2 and 3 hereof the right to members to transfer their shares shall be restricted as follows;
 - (a) No share shall be transferred to a person who is not a member so long as any member of any person selected by the Directors as one who it is desirable in the interest of the Company to admit to membership.
 - (b) Every shareholder or trustee in bankruptcy, or any person who may desire to sell or transfer any such shares and every personal representatives of a deceased shareholder shall give notice in writing to the Directors that he desires to make such sale or transfer. Such notice shall constitute the Board of Directors of the Company as his agent for the sale of the said shares to any member or members of the company at the price to be agreed upon between the party giving such notice the party and the board, or in case of difference to be determined by the Auditor of the Company.
 - (c) Upon price of such shares being agreed on a determined as per clause (b) above, the board shall forthwith give notice to such of the shareholders other than the shareholders desiring to sell or transfer the said shares, stating the number and price of such share inviting the person to whom notice is sent to state within 21 days from the date of such notice whether he is willing to purchase any, if so what maximum number of such shares. At the expiration of such days 21 notice the board shall apportion such shares amongst the shareholders (if more than one) who shall have expressed their desire to purchase number of shares already held by them respectively, or if there be only one such shareholder, that the whole of such shares shall be sold to him, provided no shareholder shall be obliged to take more than the maximum number of such shares stated in his answer to the said notice.

Upon such apportionment being made or such one shareholder notifying his intention to purchase, as the case may be, the party desiring to sell or transfer such shares shall be bound upon payment of the said price to transfer the shares to the respective shareholders or to single shareholder who shall have agreed to purchase the same.

FORFEITURE OF SHARE

5. If a member fails to pay any call or installment of a call on the day appointed for the payment thereof, the Directors may, at any time thereafter during such time as may part of such call or installment remain unpaid serve a notice on him requiring payment of so much of the call or installment as unpaid, together with any interest which may have accrued.
6. The notice shall have a further day (not earlier than the expiration of fourteen days from the date of the notice) on or before which the payment required by the notice is to be made and shall state that in the event of non-payment at or before the time appointed the shares in respect of which the call made will liable to be forfeited.
7. If the requirement of such notice as aforesaid are not complied with any share in respect of the notice given, may at any time thereafter before the payment require by the notice has been made for forfeited by a resolution of the Directors to that effect.
8. A forfeited share may be sold or otherwise disposed of on such terms and in such a manner as the Directors think fit, and at any time before a sale or disposition the forfeiture may be cancelled on such terms as the Directors think fit.
9. A person whose shares have been forfeited shall cease to be a member in respect of the forfeited shares, but shall notwithstanding remain liable to pay to the Company all money which at the date of the forfeiture were presently payable by him to the Company receives payment in full of the normal amount of the shares.
10. Statutory declaration in writing that the declarant is a Director of the company, and that a share in the company has been duly forfeited on a date stated in the declaration shall be conclusive evidence of the fact state there in as against all persons claiming to be entitled to the share. The company may receive the consideration if any given for the share on any sale or disposition thereof and the holder of the share shall not be bound to see to the application of the purchase money, if any nor shall his title to share be affected by any irregularity or invalidity in the proceedings in reference to the forfeiture, sale or disposal of the share.
11. The provisions of these regulations as to forfeiture shall apply in the case of non-payment of any sum which by the terms of issue of a share become payable at a fixed time, whether on account of the amount of the share or by way of premium as if the same has been payable by virtue of a call dully made and notified.

12. GENERAL MEETINGS: NOTICE OF GENERAL MEETING AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE GENERAL MEETINGS

The regulation of Companies Act shall apply to the following variations:

- a) A general Meeting, Ordinary or Extraordinary may with the consent in writing of all members be convened on a shorter notice than seven days or without notice.
- b) Two members, present either personally or by proxy shall form a quorum.
- c) Any ordinary resolution of the company determined without any general meeting and evidence by writing under the hands of majority of the Directors and of the members of the company holding three-fourths of the issued shares of the company shall be valid and effectual as an ordinary resolution duly passed at a general meeting of the company.

DIRECTORS

- a) Until otherwise determined by the company in General Meeting the Directors shall not be less than two and not more than seven in number.
 - b) The following persons shall be the first Directors of the company:
 1. JACKSON HUMPHREY MAKUNDI
 2. PRAYGOD HUMPHREY MAKUNDI
 3. ITAEL JACKSON MAKUNDI
13. The shareholding qualification for Directors may be fixed by the company in General Meeting, and unless and until so fixed no qualification shall be required.
14. The quorum of Directors for transacting business shall, unless otherwise fixed by Directors, be three.
15. A resolution in writing signed by all the Directors then in Tanzania shall be as valid and effectual as if it had been passed at a meeting of Directors duly called and constituted.
16. The Directors may from time to time borrow or raise any money for the purposes of the Company which may exceed the issued share capital of the company.

BORROWING POWERS

The Directors may from time to time in their discretion raise or borrow for the purpose of any Company's business such sum or sums of money as they think fit.

17. The directors may secure the repayment of or rise any such sum or sums as aforesaid by mortgage or charge upon the whole or part of the property and assets of the company present or future including uncalled capital for the time being, or by the issue at such price as they may think fit, of bonds or debentures either charges upon the whole or any part of the property and assets for the company or not so charged or in such other way as directors thinks expedient.

VOTE OF MEMBERS

18. On a show of hands every member present in person shall have one vote. On roll every member shall have one vote only fir the shares of which he is a holder
19. No member shall be entitled to vote at any general meeting unless all calls or other sums presently by him in respect of shares in the company have been paid.

DISQUALIFICATION OF DIRECTOR

20. The office of the director shall be vacated if the director
- a) Becomes bankruptcy; or
 - b) Is found to be a lunatic or becomes of unsound mind; or
 - c) Resigns his office by notice in writing to the company
 - d) Abstains hiself from meetings of the directors for a period of six months without special leave of absence from the other directors

SEAL

21. The Directors shall provide for the safe Custody of the Seal. The seal of the Company shall not be affixed to any instrument except by the authority of a resolution of the Directors and in the presence of at least two directors or a director and secretary or other person as aforesaid shall sign every instrument to which the Seal of the company is so affixed in their presence.

ALTERNATE DIRECTORS

22. Any director shall have power to nominate any person to act or attend as alternate director during his absence or during his inability so to act. Such director shall be subjected in all respect to the terms and conditions existing with reference to the other directors and such alternate director shall exercise and discharge all the duties of director whom he represent.

23. Unless otherwise decided by the directors, the quorum necessary to transact business of the directors shall be two directors personally present.

SECRETARY

24. The Secretary shall be appointed by the board of for such term, at such remuneration and upon such conditions as it may think fit and any secretary so appointed may be removed by the board.

WINDING UP

25. With the sanction of a special resolution of the shareholders any part of the assets of the company including any shares in other companies may be divided between the members of the company in special or may vested in trustees for the benefit of such members and the liquidation of the company may be closed and the company dissolved but so that no member shall be compelled to accept any shares whereupon there is any liability

ALTERNATION OR ADDITION

26. Subject to the provisions of the Act and to those contained in the memorandum of association the company may by special resolution make alteration or addition so made shall be as valid and effectual as if originally contained in those articles and be subject in like manner to alteration by special resolution.

INDEMNITY

27. Every director, Managing Director, Agent, Auditor, Secretary and other officer for the time being of the company shall be indemnified out of the assets of the company against any liability incurred by him in defending any proceeding, whether civil or criminal in which judgment is given in his favor or in which he is acquitted or is in connection with any application in which relief is granted to him by the court

ARBITRATION

28. If and whenever any dispute or difference shall arise between the company and any of the member or their respective representatives touching upon the construction or meaning of any of the Articles herein contained or any act matter or thing made or done or omitted to done or with regard to the rights or liabilities arising here under or arising out of the relation existing between the parties by reasons of these Articles or Act , such differences shall (Unless a sole arbitrator be agree upon) forthwith be referred to the arbitration of three 3) arbitrators , one to be appointed by each party and the third to be appointed by the first two or, in the event of failure to agree within (Cap .15) or any thereof existjng statutory modifications or re-enactment thereof shall apply.
