LIMITED is a foreign company dully registered and operating under the laws of Tanzania following its incorporation through certificate of compliance with registration number **25326** issued on 16th May 1994. Its main activities are tour operator and owner of more than 10 tourist accommodation facilities such as lodges, tented camps and mobile camps in Serengeti, Arusha and Manyara.

In course of implementing its activities, the company was issued with certificate of incentive for specific project in Serengeti Mara and the project has been completed long time and its up and running successfully. The incentives assigned in the said project certificate has expired as it was issued for that specific project upon meeting all TIC requirements.

That the company is currently in process of implementing new project such as construction of permanent tented camp at the Saadan National Park upon being granted concession agreement by the Registered Trustees of Tanzania National Park. The letter for grant of camp site and Concession Lease Agreement is attached for your review.

The project will involve construction of about 10 independent tents for phase-1 and the expansion will follow for the next phase which is to be implemented during the next year. For a start the construction work intends to offer employment opportunity to about 70 local employees while the operational phase will accommodate about 30 local employees for a start at this particular camp (site employees) while excluding the employees at management position which is about 30 employees who are located at the company's headquarters in Arusha. The company as it stands today in exclusion of this new project offers employment to more than 200 local employees.

We also wish to mention that, in course of implementing this project, the company intends to import various construction materials, equipment as well as vehicles which are crucial for project implementation as well as tour operations once facility is up and running.

These incentives are aimed at assisting the company in importation of the construction materials and tour vehicles which cost significant amount of financial investment. The importation is due by mid-February 2024 and therefore your earliest response is appreciated in advance.
