

TANZANIAN CHICKPEA PROGRAMME

MATERIAL TRANSFER AGREEMENT

This agreement follows discussions between:

Wherry & Sons Ltd, The Old School, Rippingdale, Bourne, Lincolnshire PE10 0SR

And

Fieldmasters Ltd, Aga Khan Manyara Farm, Ngeromtoni, Arusha. Tanzania

Purpose

The purpose of the programme is to follow Wherry research in identifying and selecting varieties that may be suitable for cultivation in Tanzania, with Fieldmaster providing the land and agronomic skills to undertake evaluations to determine crop viability leading to contract production tonnage.

Obligations

1. Wherry will supply free of charge seed of the following selected varieties and lines, (material) varieties Badil, Flamenco and line Tzar for sowing 2024.
2. Wherry will cover costs of air freight to Tanzania.
3. Where appropriate, Wherry will provide technical assistance to support this programme.
4. Upon harvest Wherry will evaluate the quality of grains produced and their suitability for markets.
5. For their part Fieldmasters will cover the cost of inland freight and customs clearance, provide at their cost land suitable for chickpea cultivation and undertake production under their direct guidance following best agronomic practice for the crop.
6. The material will be sown in individual blocks allowing for comparative assessment.
7. Fieldmasters will provide in season growing reports of the material.
8. Fieldmasters will harvest the material with care ensuring segregation of the material.
9. The harvested grain may be used for reestablishment of commercial crops in 2025 so care should be exercised in its drying and storage
10. All harvested material to be retained by Fieldmasters where Wherry will evaluate individual samples as to their suitability for markets.

Beyond harvest 2024

11. Following harvest Wherry and Fieldmasters will discuss the options and viability of upscaling production and the suitability of the material to meet both agronomic performance and, the market specifications required.
12. From that point Wherry and Fieldmasters will agree the terms for exclusive contracted production programme in Tanzania.

13. The sole purpose of this agreement is to establish exclusive contracted production between Wherry and Fieldmasters and the harvest grain must only be used for this purpose unless agreed otherwise by the two parties.
