- Registrar of Companies
1. The name of the company " **VOLT AFRICA LIMITED** "
 2. The Registered office of the Company will be situated in Tanzania.
 3. The objects for which the company is established are:-
 - (a) To carry on the business as general suppliers of all sorts and types electrical & electronics or printing material and service to individuals, offices, industries, shops, schools, factories, hospitals, army, military, ministries and all other government offices, universities and all other places where the services of a supplier are needed.
 - b) To carry on the business of dealing in importing, exporting, marketing, manufacturing stocking, buying, selling whether by wholesale or retail of various categories of goods and merchandise and to act as commission agents, brokers, insurance agents and manufacturers, representatives in all fields. To establish business enterprises whether small scale, industries and generally deal in all kinds of general merchants and to import, export and all either by merchandise and articles of all description.
 - c) To carry on business of exploration, research and drilling of fuel and gaseous, petrol service station and deal in petrol, diesel, oil, kerosene, mineral oil, crude oil, lubrication oil, grease, all kind of gaseous and / or fuel oil of all kinds and all other kinds of mineral and petroleum products as importers, dealer or distributors and servicing and repairing of vehicles of all types generally.
 - d) To carry on the business of transportation, cargo and travel agents, commission agents, customs agents, insurance agents, tourist agents, manufacturers representatives, clearing and forwarding agents, road contractors, cargo superintendents, packers, machinery haulage specialists, warehousemen, engineers, electricians, motor cars, cabs, omnibus, lorries, oil tank and coach proprietors and transporters by any other means of conveyance of people and goods in Tanzania and the neighbouring countries and in such other place or places as may from time to time determined by the Company.
 - (e) To engage and or carry on the business of road constructions, engineering, general civil works, buildings, renovations, office petitioners, decoratories, maintainers of dilapidated buildings, plumbing, furniture manufactures, suppliers and exporters, residential and office furnishers and general to be designers and fabricators of all kinds of gadgets whatsoever, to be timber processors, saw millers and suppliers of all kinds of timber, to be hardware and building materials suppliers, manufactures of electrical equipments and suppliers of same.
 - (f) To carry on the business of training, strategic marketing, project management, act as consultants of educational content programmes, educational infrastructure, educational technologies and operate schools such as nursery, primary, secondary, colleges and

vocational training centers. carry on all or any of the business, by wholesales and/or retail a training equipments.

- (g) To engage in and carry on business of profession of farmers, supply of agricultural suppliments such as fertilities, seeds, agricultural equipments, planters, harvesters, sprayers, seed growers, glaziers breeders, sellers of and dealers of livestock, market gardeners, arboriculturarists, horticulturalists, floriculturists, dairymen, vegetable oil extract, poultry and bee-keepers and any other business in connection with floriculture, arboriculture, agriculture and horticulture.
- (h) To carry on the business of farming, planters, growers, cultivators, horticulturists, market gardeners, agriculturists and buyer of every kinds of vegetables and fruits to prepare farms of coffee, rice, maize, sugarcane, banana plants, beans, tomatoes, onion, and other products, to preserve process cure, blend, refine trait, manufacture and render marketable any such produce and to sell, dispose and deal in a produce either in its prepared, manufactured raw or other state and either in its prepared.
- (i) To carry on the business as exporters, traders, suppliers, general merchants, stockiest, wholesalers, retailers and dealers in business of scrapers, agricultural machinery, implements, equipment and all kinds of industrial projects machinery.
- (j) To build, construct, alter, improve, enlarge, repair, maintain, develop, demolish, remove or replace and to work, manage, carry out or control works of all descriptions, including but not limited to offices, factories, mills, warehouse, shops, stores, garages and other buildings, roads, machinery and plants, which may, in the opinion of the directors of the company, be likely to advance directly the company's interests; to clear sites for the same, to contribute to, subsidies or otherwise assist in the building, construction, alternation, repair, improve, enlargement, maintenance, development, demolition, removal, replacement, working, management, carrying out or control. To be professional services contractors, fumigation agents, renovators.
- (k) To carry on the business as traders, consumers, suppliers, general merchants, importers, exporters, stockiest, wholesalers, retailers and dealers in all types of electrical goods, hardware, building materials, spare parts and maintenance , tyres, tubes, tools, and accessories for all types of automotive, motor vehicles, agricultural machinery, implements, equipment, all kinds of industrial projects machinery and equipment, timber , fishing gears, groceries, computers, office equipments, cooking oils, salts, foodstuffs, cosmetics, oils, paints, spirits sheets, hinges, screws, iron mongery, textiles piece goods, all types of leather goods, shoes, bags and other similar goods.
- (l) To engage in and or otherwise carry on the business of environmental protection and management, financial management, fumigation, sanitary services, super cleaners, removal treatment contractors, rural, urban and community centers cleaners, landscapers to be professional sanitary services contractors, promoters of health services in governmental departments, offices, companies, public or private institutions, individual and any other organization all over the world.
- (m) To engage in and carry on all or of the business of manufactures of and dealers, and workers in cement, lime plasters, clay, whittlings, gravel, stone chippings, minerals, eat, fuel, artificial stones, bricks tiles, tiles, roofing's, pipes, pottery earthenware, china sanitary and conveniences of all kinds and as well as tone crushers and quarry owners.

- (n) To carry on the business of importers, exporters, general merchants, general store-keepers, universal providers, wholesale and/or retail traders, dealers of piece wood, paints, hardware, glassware, crockery, cutlery, ironmongery, turners and other household fittings and requirements, other articles and commodities of personal, household use and consumption provisions, textiles, groceries, medicines, drugs, wines, spirits, liquors, chemical, surgical, optical, photographic and other instruments, apparatus and materials, motor vehicles, automobiles and generally in all manufactured goods of all types and merchandise of all kinds.
- (o) To search for; inspect, examine and explore, purchase, take on lease, peg, or otherwise acquire, for any interest therein, land tenements or here detements of any tenure and in any place which may seem to the Company capable of affording a supply of gems minerals or mineral oil, and to develop, work, win, get, quarry mine crush, assay, amalgamate, reduce and smelt, as the case may be sapphire, tanzanite, diamonds, gold, silver platinum, copper, nickel and other precious gems, metals and stones, tin, copper, lead, coal, mica, quicksilver and other base metals ore and minerals of whatsoever kind and description.
- (p) To carry on and deal in the business of pharmaceuticals, medical preparations, chemicals, animal feeds, manufacturing, making and assembling of machines equipments, plants, vessels, devises of all descriptions using modern technology appropriate and applicable to veterinary and agricultural industries.
- (q) To carry on business of running supermarkets, shopping malls, retail shops, wholesale outlets, act as importers, exporters, clearing agents, stock list, processors, warehouse men, agents, dealers and to generally deal in all types of consumer goods, hardware goods, and building and property maintains, groceries, mining and exploration of all kinds precious stones, Fuel, food stuffs, beverages of all description, precisions items, gemstones, jeweler, rate items, dress materials and clothing and all any types of goods, merchandises tock or item of any number, size, magnitude, description and type whatsoever and operate, plague, lighter, barges and all other vessels and craft of any kind whatsoever including aircraft and any purchase assignment exchange, general trading, transferor any part of undertaking and all general merchandise.
- (r) To carry on the business of export and or import of bid, carvings, artworks, woodworks, guiding aids, artistic and or demonstration tools, business promotion apparatus and or timber products, forest produce, designers of arts and representations thereof, dealers in carvings of all kinds, types and description whatsoever.
- (s) To promote tourism in Tanzania and elsewhere in Africa, to carry on business of travel and tourist agents and tour operators, to promote facilitate traveling to organize hurting, tented-camps, fishing and diving expeditions, safari promoters and undertakers generally and in particular to arrange and manager hunting safaris, photo safaris adventure tours, fishing trips, handling of game trophies and animal skins, catching, harboring, transporting, wildlife and marine products of all kind.
- (t) To carry on the business of big game hunter, trapping and collection of wild, live birds for sale and export within outside Tanzania, to sell, improved export, and imports, prepare, deal and trade in carvings, painting, curios, export, and provide game sanctuary facilities and to organize of safaris and expeditions. Discover, hunt, shoot, photograph, capture animals, birds, game and fish of all kinds including reptiles, marine products,

pottery crafts, crustacean, salt, mangrove sea shells, groceries, vegetables, cereals good, fruits and all allied products of every description.

- (u) To carry on the business as general food processors packers and suppliers, to be general suppliers of hard foods stuffs and agricultural crops. To be grain millers and food mixers to be general exporters of fresh fruits vegetables and flowers, to act as agents of buying and selling building hardware of every description, electrical appliances, lease.
- (v) To engage in and carry out the business of proprietors and managers of hotels, restaurants, cafes, road houses, motels, safari and holiday camps, caravan sites, guest houses, apartment housekeepers, refreshment and tea rooms, milk and snacks bars, tavern, beer house and lodging housekeepers and to provide food and catering services to individuals, private and public institutions and business concerns.
- (w) To carry on all or any of the business of transport, carriage and haulage contractors, owners and charter of road vehicles, aircraft and ships and boats of every description and carriers of goods and passenger by road, rail, water or air and to establish, acquire, maintain and operate transport service of every description both public and private and all services ancillary thereto and such purposes or as independent undertakings to purchase, take in exchange, charter, hire, build, contract or otherwise acquire and to own, operate, work, manage, maintain, repair, service and deal with and in road vehicles, aircraft and vessels the country or any other state in Africa or Europe or Asia and or any other foreign country.
- (x) To carry on the business of garage proprietors and service station for motor vehicles of all kinds, to carry on the safe keeping, cleaning, repairing, refueling, panel beating, spraying and the general care of motor vehicles, aircraft, machinery, equipment and plant whether moved by mechanical power or not, implements, utensils, appliances, apparatus, fuel for internal combustion engines, lubricants, cements, solutions, batteries and accessories and all things capable of being used in connection with the said businesses or in the manufacture or maintenance of such vehicles, machinery, equipment and plant.
- (y) To carry out of the business of providing technical and allied services in the field of welding, metal fabrication, on destructive testing, quality assurances, and to provide consultancy in technical services, oil storage tank erections and all other businesses which can be married out in connection to the above.
- (z) To carry on all any of the wholesale and/or retail as gemstones merchants, jewelers and/or dealers in and/or buy, sell market import export and/or general deal in all or any kinds of gemstones precious and semi-precious stones, gold silver and precious metals of whatsoever kind or discrimination.
- (aa) To purchase, take on lease and otherwise acquire for investment or resale any estate, land, buildings easements and other rights and interests in immovable property or any tenure in Tanzania and elsewhere and to sell let or lease exchange or otherwise dispose of or grant rights over any immovable property of any kind.
- (bb) To purchase, take or lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire and hold any state or interest in any lands buildings, casements, rights, licenses secret processes, machinery, plants, stock, in trade and real or personal property of any kind.

- (cc) To accept payment for any property or rights sold or otherwise disposed or dealt with by the company either in cash, by installment or otherwise or in fully or paid up shares of the company or corporation, with or without deferred or preferred or guaranteed rights.
- (dd) To carry any other trade or business whatever which can be in the opinion of the Board of Directors be advantageously carried on the Company in connection with the above business or the general business of the company.
- (ee) To act as agents for the sale and purchase of any stocks shares or securities or for any other monetary or mercantile transactions.
- (ff) To act as executors and trustees of wills and settlements made by customers and others and undertake and execute trusts of all kinds.
- (gg) To do all or any of the above things in any part of the world and either as principals, agents, trustees, contractors or otherwise, and either alone or in conjunction with others and either or through agents, sub-contractors, trustees and otherwise
- (hh) To remunerate any person, firm or company rendering services to this company, whether by cash payments or by allotment to him or them of shares or securities of the company credited and paid in full or in part, otherwise.
- (ii) To accept for safe custody and keep for customers of the company all kinds of securities valuables and things.
- (ij) To lend money on any terms that may thought fit, and particularly to customers or other person or corporations having dealing with societies and to give any guarantees that may be expedient.
- (kk) To advance money to shareholders in the company, and other to the purpose of enabling the person borrowing the same erect or purchase, or enlarge or repair any house or building or to purchase the fee simple or any less estate or interest in, or to take a demise for any term or terms of years of any freehold or leasehold property upon such terms and conditions as the company may think fit.
- (ll) To invest and deal with the moneys of the company not immediately required, upon such securities and in such manner as may from time to time be determined.
- (mm) To distribute among the members in pieces any property of the company, or any proceeds of sale or disposal of any property of the company.
- (nn) To draw, make, accept, endorse, discount execute and issue promissory notes, bills of lading, warrants, debentures and negotiable or transferable instruments.
- (oo) To act as agents or brokers, and as trustees for any person firm or company, and to undertake and perform sub-contractors and also to act in any other business of the company through or by means of agents, brokers, sub-contractors or others.
- (pp) To obtain any provisional order, act of parliament for enabling the company to carry any of it is objects into effect, or for affecting any modification of the company's constitution, or any other purpose which may seem expedient, and to oppose any proceedings or applications which may seem calculated, directly or indirectly to benefit the company.

- (qq) To take or otherwise and hold shares in any other company having objects altogether or in part similar to this company, or carrying on any business capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit the company.
- (rr) To transact or carry on all kinds of Agency business and in particular in relation to the investment of money, the sale of property, and the collection and receipt of money.
- (ss) To do all other things as may be deemed incidental or conducive to the entertainment of the objects or any of them.

And it is hereby declared that:-

The word "company" in this clause, except where used in reference to this company, shall be deemed to include any partnership or other body of persons, whether corporate or incorporate, and whether domiciled in the United Republic of Tanzania or elsewhere.

The object specified in each of the paragraphs of the paragraph of this clause shall be regarded as independent objects, and accordingly shall in no way be limited or restricted (except where otherwise expressed in such paragraphs) by reference to or inference from the terms of any other paragraph of the name of the company but may be carried out in as full and ample a manner and construed in as wide a sense as if each of the said paragraph define the objects of the separate and distinct compound.

That the meaning of any general word or words in any paragraph of this clause shall not be restricted by being construed ejusdem generic with any particular word or words in the same paragraph.



AND it is hereby declare that the word "Company" in this clause, except where used in reference of this company, shall be deemed to include any partnership or other body of persons, whether incorporated, and whether domiciled in Tanzania or elsewhere, and that the intention is that each of the objects set forth in any sub-clause or by the same of the company. PRELIMINARY.

1. In these regulations:-
"The Act mean" the companies Act 2002 of the Laws of Tanzania.

When any provision of the Act is referred to the reference is that provision is as modified by any law for the time being in force.

Unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions defined in the Act or any statutory modification thereof in the force at the date at which these regulations become binding on the company, shall have the meaning so defined.

Any words importing the singular shall include the plural and vice versa, and words importing the masculine gender shall include females, and the words importing persons shall include bodies corporate, partnership, firms, cooperatives, societies, etc.

The regulations of Companies Act shall not apply to the company, save in so far as they are varied or excluded hereby, but in case of any conflict between the provisions herein, and the provisions under this regulation the former shall prevail, and in addition to substitution shall be the regulation of the Company.

PRIVATE COMPANY.

The Company is a Private Company and accordingly:-

- a) The right to transfer shares is restricted in manner hereinafter prescribed.
- b) The number of members of the company (exclusive of persons who are in the employment of the company and who have been formerly in the employment of the company were while in such employment to be the member of the company) is limited fifty, provided that where two or more persons hold one or more shares in the company jointly they shall for the purpose of this regulation be tested as a single member.
- c) (c)Any invitation to the public to subscribe for any shares or debentures of the company is prohibited.
- d) (d)The company shall not have power to issue share warrants to bearer.

TRANSFER OF SHARES.

- e) The Directors may in their direction and without assigning any reason thereof refuse to register the transfer of any share to any person who it shall in their opinion be undesirable for any reason whatsoever to admit to membership.
- f) Subject to clause 2 and 3 hereof the right to members to transfer their shares shall be restricted as follows;
- g) (a) No share shall be transferred to a person who is not a member so long as any member of any person selected by the Directors as one whom it is desirable in the interest of the Company to admit to membership.
- h) (b) Every shareholder or trustee in bankruptcy, or any person who may desire to sell or transfer any such shares and every who may desire to sell or transfer any such shares and every personal representatives of a deceased shareholder shall give notice in writing to the Directors that he desires to make such sale transfer. Such notice shall constitute the Board of the Directors in the company as his agent for the sale of the said shares to any member of members of the company at the price to be agreed upon between the party giving such notice the party and the board, or in the case of difference to be determined by the Author of the Company.
- i) (c) Upon price of such shares being agreed on a determined as per clause(b) above, the board shall forthwith give notice to such of the shareholders other than the shareholders desiring to sell or transfer the said shares, stating the number and price of such share inviting the person to whom notice is sent to state within of such 21 days from the date of such notice whether he is willing to purchase any, notice the board shall apportion such shares amongst the shareholders (if more than one) Who shall have expressed there be only one such shareholder, that the whole of such shares be sold to him, provided no shareholder shall be obliged to take more than the maximum number of such shares stated in his answer to the said notice.
- j) Upon such appointment being made or such one shareholder notifying his intention to purchase, as the case may be, the party desiring to sell or transfer such shares shall be bound upon payment of the said price to transfer the shares to the respective shareholders or to single shareholder who shall have agreed to purchase the same.

GENERAL MEETINGS: NOTICE OF GENERAL MEETING AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE GENERAL MEETINGS.

The Regulation of Companies Act shall apply the following variations:-

- (a) A general Meeting, Ordinary or Extraordinary may with the consent in writing of all members, be convened on a shorter notice than seven days or without notice.
- (b) Two members, present either personally or by proxy shall form a quorum.
- (c) Any ordinary resolution of the company determined without any general meeting and evidenced by writing under the hands of majority of the Directors and of the members of the company holding three – fourths of the issued shares of the company shall be valid and effectual as an ordinary resolution duly passed at a general meeting of the company.

DIRECTORS

- a) Until otherwise determined by the company in General Meeting the Directors shall not be less than two and not more than seven in number.
 - b) The following persons shall be the first Directors of the company
 - 1. JOSEPH JASSON RWEBANGIRA.
 - 2. EDSON WILLIAM UHALE.
5. The shareholding qualification for directors may be fixed by the company in General meeting, and unless and until so fixed no qualification shall be required.
6. The quorum of Directors for transacting business shall, unless otherwise fixed by the Directors, be two.
7. A resolution in writing signed by all the Directors then in Tanzania shall be as valid and effectual as if it had been passed at a meeting of Directors duly called and constituted.
8. The Directors may from time to time borrow or raise any money for the purpose of the company which may exceed the issued share capital of the company.
9. If and whenever any dispute or difference shall arise between the company and any of the members or their respective representatives touching upon the construction or meaning of any of the Act herein contained or any act matter or thing made or done or omitted to be done or with regard to the rights or liabilities arising here under or arising out of the relation existing between the parties by reasons of these Act such differences shall (unless a sole arbitrator be agreed upon forthwith be referred to the arbitration of three (3) arbitrators, one to be appointed by each party and the third to be appointed by the first two or, in the event of failure to agree within (cap. 15) or any then existing statutory modifications or re-enactment thereof shall apply.

BORROWING POWERS.

- k) The Directors may from time to time in their discretion raise or borrow for the purpose of any Company's business such sum of money as they think fit.
- l) The Directors may secure the repayment of or raise any such sum or sums as aforesaid by mortgage or charge upon the whole or any part of the property and assets of the company present or future including its uncalled capital for the time being, or by the issue at such price as they may think fit, of bonds or debentures either charged upon the whole or any part of the property and assets of the company or not so charged or in such other way as the Directors may think expedient.

VOTE OF MEMBERS.

- m) On a show of hands every member present in person shall have one vote.
- n) On a roll every member shall have one vote only for the shares of which he is holder.
- o) No member shall be entitled to vote at any general meeting unless all calls or other sums presently by him in respect of shares in the Company have been paid.

DISQUALIFICATION OF DIRECTORS.

- p) 14. The office of a Director shall be vacated if the Director;
 - q) Becomes bankrupt; or
 - r) Is found to be a lunatic or becomes of unsound mind; or
 - s) Resigns his office by notice in writing to the company;
 - t) Abstains himself from meetings of the directors for a
 - u) Period of six months without special leave of absence
 - v) From the other Directors.

SEAL

- w) The Directors shall provide for the safe custody of the seal. The seal of the company shall not be affixed to any instrument except by the authority of a resolution of the Board of Directors and in the presence of at least two Directors or a Director and Secretary or other as aforesaid shall sign every instrument to which the seal of the company is so affixed in their presence.
- x) Any director shall have power to nominate any person to act or attend as alternate Director during his absence or during his inability so to act. Such Director shall be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions existing with reference to the other Directors and such Alternate Director shall excise and discharge all the duties of Director whom he represents.
- y) Unless otherwise decided by the Directors the quorum necessary to transact business of the Directors shall be two Directors personally present.

SECRETARY.

- z) The secretary shall be appointed by the Board for such terms at such remuneration and upon such condition as it may think fit, and any Secretary so appointed may be removed by the Board.

WINDING UP



- aa) With the sanction of a special resolution of the shareholders any part of the assets of the company including any shares in other companies may be vested in Trustees for the benefit of such members and the liquidation of the company may be closed and the company dissolved but so that no member shall be compelled to accept any shares whereupon there is any liability.

ALTERNATION OR ADDITION

- bb) Subject to the provisions of the Act and to those contained in the Memorandum of Association the Company may by Special Resolution make alteration or addition so made shall be as valid and effectual as if originally contained in those articles and be subject in like manner to alteration by Special Resolution.

INDEMNITY.

- cc) Every Director, Managing Director, Agent, Auditor, Secretary and other Officer for the time being of the company shall be indemnified out of the Assets of the company against any liability incurred by him in defending any proceedings, whether civil or criminal in which judgment is given in his
- dd) favour or in which he is acquitted or is in connection with any application (under section 481 of the Act) in which relief is granted to him by the court.
- ee) If and whenever any dispute or difference shall arise between the company and any of the members or their respective representatives touching upon the construction or meaning of any of the Act herein contained or any act matter or thing made or done or omitted to be done or with regard to the rights or liabilities arising here under or arising out of the relation existing between the parties by reasons of these Act such differences shall (unless a sole arbitrator be agreed upon forthwith be referred to the arbitration of three 3) arbitrators, one to be appointed by each party and the third to be appointed by the first two or, in the event of failure to agree within (cap. 15) or any then existing statutory modifications or re-enactment thereof shall apply.
