**SUBJECT: Application for New Certificate of Incentives**

**Project Background:**

Bagamoyo Sugar Limited (BSL), a unit of Bakhresa Group, was incorporated on 1st December 2016 with the main objective of establishing a sugarcane plantation and manufacturing sugar to alleviate the shortfall in domestic sugar production. BSL was established in compliance with the directive by the Government of Tanzania for Bakhresa Group to invest on a green field sugar project on 10,000 Ha of land in Makurunge Village of Bagamoyo district allotted by Govt. This move was part of the Government's initiative to reduce dependency on sugar imports and to drive an increase in domestic sugar production. This land is situated along the Wami River.

**Progress Made So Far:**

Under Phase 1 of the implementation of the project, BSL planted sugar cane on 2000 Ha of land and installed and commissioned 1,500 tons per day crushing capacity Sugar Plant. By now, BSL has completed the third season of harvesting sugar cane and producing sugar.

**Expansion Plan/ Investment Objective**

The company intends for expand Sugar Plant from 1500 TCD to 3500 TCD and increase the area under cultivation from 2000 Ha to 3000 Ha.

**Investment Cost and Sources of Finance**

The total project cost for capex expansion is estimated at US\$10m. The required funds for the project expansion shall be mobilized through a combination of internal accruals from group companies amounting to USD 6.5 Million and external financing from banking institutions amounting to USD 3.5 Million respectively.

### **Job Creation**

The expansion of the sugar project will lead to increased job creation for a total number of 100 people, both directly in agriculture and processing, and indirectly through supporting industries such as transport, maintenance, and local services.

### **Sources of Supply of Inputs**

All major equipment required for the project will be procured from established manufacturers in Asia/Europe, leveraging the region's advanced manufacturing capabilities and favorable cost structures.

### **Marketing Plan**

Given that the current demand for sugar exceeds domestic supply, the government is committed to encouraging local/domestic production of sugar to reduce reliance on imports and enhance food security. This initiative aims to reduce dependency on imported sugar, support local farmers and processors, and strengthen the country's agro-industrial base.
