Project Overview

Our project commenced in 2021 with the acquisition of specialized equipment and machinery valued at USD 4 million for the purpose of drying spices. At the initial stage, operations were set up at a rented facility provided by BH Ladwa, which served as our primary production site.

Expansion and Growth

Over the course of two years, as the business expanded and production capacity increased, it became evident that establishing a permanent facility would be more sustainable in the long term. Recognizing this need, we made the strategic decision to acquire land and construct our own factory to support our growing operations.
