## PROJECT PROGRESS REPORT

Project Location: Kipili, Lake Tanganyika  
Reporting Period: Last Six (6) Months

### Introduction

This report outlines the progress made on our investment project at Lake Tanganyika over the past six months. During this period, significant construction and infrastructure developments have been completed, contributing substantially to the operational capacity and long-term objectives of the project, Lake Shore Lodge and Campsite.

#### 1. Construction of New 5-Bedroom Facility

We successfully completed the construction of a new five-bedroom accommodation building, designed to support both guests and operational needs. The facility includes:

- Five (5) bedrooms
- Separate bathroom and shower facilities
- Eight (8) toilets
- Six (6) showers
- Kitchen and pantry
- Lounge area
- Dining area
- Conference room

This building is now complete and ready for use.

#### 2. Development of Research Centre

Significant progress has been made on the Research Centre, which includes:

- Four (4) ensuite bedrooms (fully completed)
- One large conference and research room (construction nearing completion)

The Research Centre will support research activities, workshops, and educational programs aligned with the project's objectives.

#### 3. Restaurant Expansion

The restaurant facility was expanded to double its original size. This was achieved by:

- Adding a new corrugated iron roofed extension
- Installing windows for improved ventilation and lighting
- Reinforcing walls to ensure durability and safety

This expansion has increased seating capacity and improved service efficiency.

#### 4. Campsite Kitchenette Facilities

To enhance campsite services, we constructed five (5) individual kitchenette areas, each equipped with:

- A sink
- Barbecue (BBQ) facilities

These additions significantly improve the comfort and self-catering options for campsite users.

#### 5. Laundry Drying Area Expansion

The laundry drying area was enlarged by:

- Adding additional roofed space
- Creating extra outdoor drying areas

This upgrade improves laundry efficiency, particularly during peak occupancy periods.

### **Conclusion**

Overall, the last six months have been highly productive, with major infrastructure milestones achieved. These developments strengthen the project's operational readiness and support its continued growth at Lake Tanganyika. Further works will focus on completing remaining structures and enhancing service delivery.
